

## 3D Binder Clip Photo Holder

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## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: A Little Wild 144344/143671
- Inks: Night Of Navy 147110, Assorted Stampin' Write Marker colors
- Cardstock: Mint Macaron138337, Whisper White100730, Blushing Bride 131198, Gray Granite 146983
- Designer Paper: Twinkle, Twinkle #146284
- Tools: Little Loves Dies 143743, Stampin' Dimensionals 104430, Tear & Tape 138995, Foam Adhesive Strips 141825
- Miscellaneous: 1-1/4" Binder Clips, thin cardboard

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Using (4) binder clips, add Tear & Tape to each side and bottom, making sure the whole binder clip is covered. Repeat for all four clips:



2. Cut a piece of designer paper to measure 5-1/8" x 2-1/8" and start by gluing to one side on one clip at a time and adding all of the clips side-by-side. Once the first side is completed with all 4 clips, press along to the underside and then over to the opposite side. You may have to trim to fit:





## 3. Frame:

Cut the following layers of designer paper and glue as shown in the photo:

- a. Layer #1: 5" x 5-1/2"
- b. Layer #2: 3" x 4-1/4"
- c. Carboard: Glue a piece of thin cardboard to the back of Layer #1 to make it sturdy. I used the cardboard from our designer paper packs:



4. Insert the frame into the four clips and make sure it is centered and straight. Glue two strips of the Foam Adhesive Strips positioned at the top of the clips. This will serve as a stopper to hold the frame layers in place:



5. Cut a strip of Mint Macaron Cardstock to measure 5-1/2" x 1". Use Paper Snips to create a banner "V" on the right end only. Stamp the sentiment using Night Of Navy Ink to the right-hand side of the banner. Glue cardstock layer over the foam adhesive about ¼" from the bottom:



6. Cut a third piece of designer paper that measures 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" and glue at an angle using Stampin' Dimensionals and tucking under the banner. Add a wallet-sized photo to the designer paper layer you just glued in place:



- 7. Decorate the frame by adding stamped images. I stamped all of the images using Night Of Navy Ink and cut them all out with the coordinating dies.
  - a. Blushing Bride Cardstock for the bears
  - b. Gray Granite Cardstock for the bee hive
  - c. Whisper White Cardstock for the flowers and bees. I also colored the flowers and bees with assorted Stampin' Write Markers:

All of the stamped images on the banner are glued with Stampin' Dimensionals. The bees and the single flower between the bears are glued flat.
