



## Stitched Seasons Concertina Card

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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

**Stamps:** First Frost (CM 148420/WM 148417), Feathers & Frost (147771)

**Die Cutting:** Frosted Bouquet Framelits (147895), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Big Shot (143263), Magnetic Platform (130658)

**BUNDLE:** First Frost Bundle (CM 149943/WM 149942)

**Cardstocks:** Galvanized Metallic Paper (147805), Sahara Sand (121043), Whisper White (100730), Mossy Meadow (133676), Soft Suede (115318), Crumb Cake (120953), Silver Foil (132178)

**DSP:** Frosted Floral Specialty (147800)

**Tools:** Banner Triple Punch (138292), Simply Scored (122334), Trimmer (126889), Snips (103579)

**Ink:** Soft Suede (147115), Mossy Meadow (147111), Tranquil Tide (147146)

**Ribbon & Twine:** Tranquil Tide 1/4" Velvet (147802), 3/16" Braided Linen Trim (147808), Linen Thread (104199)

**Misc:** Chicken Wire Elements (147807), Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Tear & Tape (138995)

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Take the largest stitched shape die in Frosted Bouquet Framelits and cut two shapes out of cardstock – these will form the outer covers...



Take the stitched shaped die the next size down and use it to cut out six pieces...



Adhere one in place onto the reverse side of the front cover...



Take four of the pieces and use your score tool to score a line down each side of each piece – this will create the tabs for adhesive...



Take the first piece, fold along one of the score lines and apply strong adhesive to it...



Adhere in place onto the same shaped area on the cover piece...



Take the next piece and cut off one of the tabs...



Apply adhesive to the tab on the piece you just stuck to the cover...



Line up and adhere your second piece onto it...



Repeat for the next two pieces until you have 4 pages in place.

Take the final piece and cut down one side – do not score the other – this is the inside of your back cover. Adhere to the tab like you did for the other pieces...



Turn over and apply strong adhesive to the back of this piece and adhere in place onto the back cover...



And this is what you will have – a concertina style card/album ready for decorating!





To cover the inside pages use any pretty colored patterned papers and use the same die to shape them...



And cut both side tabs off and adhere in place...



This is what your card will look like on the reverse side – neat and tidy but you can cover these sections with papers too if you would like...



This is how I decorated mine – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:









And on the very back a space to write a message...
