Supplies:

- Stamps: Spooky Sweets (CM 147716/WM 147719)
- BUNDLE: Spooky Sweets Bundle (CM 149973/WM 149974)
- Designer Series Paper: Toil & Trouble (147531)
- Punches: Spooky Bats (148014), Everyday Label (144668), 1 1/4" Circle (119861), 1 3/4" Circle (119850), 1/8" Circle (134365)
- Cardstocks: Crushed Curry (131199), Whisper White (100730), Vellum (101856), Black Foil Sheets (147898)
- Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
- Ribbons & Twine: Black 3/8" Glittered Organdy Ribbon (147897), White Solid Bakers Twine (124262)
- Misc: 2" x 8" Cellophane Bags (141703), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Dimensionals (144108), Snail (104332)



Instructions:

- Use the Everyday Label Punch to cut the Crushed Curry tag base
- Cut a strip of starry patterned paper from Toil & Trouble DSP to measure 2 1/2" x 1/4" and adhere across the center of the tag base
- Use the 1 3/4" Circle Punch to cut out a piece of Vellum Cardstock and adhere on top of the strip
- Stamp your sentiment in black ink and use the 1 1/4" Circle Punch to cut it out use Dimensionals to layer it on to the Vellum Circle
- Use the Spooky Bats Punch to cut a bat out of Black Foil paper and use Mini Dimensionals to adhere to the white circle
- Make a small hole in the top of the yellow tag base and thread through a length of Solid White Bakers Twine
- Take your Cellophane Bag and fill with treats when done, use a piece of Black Glittered Organdy Ribbon to tie it closed
- Use the White Bakers Twine to tie the tag around the bag top and finish with a bow in front and now your spooky bag of treats is ready for giving!

To step this project up a notch you can emboss the tag base and shape the patterned paper strip by cutting a V in each end:

On the tag below I used the Swirls & Curls Embossing Folder (147923) to do this and used my Banner Triple Punch (138292) to cut the V shapes...
