Supplies:

- Stamps: Country Home (147678)
- Die Cutting & Embossing: Tin Tile Embossing Folder (147906), Layering Ovals Framelits (141706), Big Shot (143263)
- Designer Series Paper: Country Lane (147804)
- Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Blackberry Bliss (133675), Pool Party (122924), Whisper White (100730), Vellum (101856), Galvanized Metallic (147805)
- Inks: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
- Blends Markers: Blackberry Bliss Light (147909), Old Olive Light (144574), Pool Party Light (144595), Cajun Craze Light (147907), Bronze (144607), Smoky Slate Light (145054)
- Punches: Leaf (144667), Banner Triple (138292)
- Ribbons & Twine: 3/16" Braided Linen Trim (147808), Linen Thread (104199)
- Misc: Chicken Wire Elements (147807), Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Brush (141897), Basic Rhinestone Jewels (144220), Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

• Early Espresso Card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

• Blackberry Bliss layer: 4 x 5 1/4"

Pool Party embossed layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
Galvanized Metallic strip: 3 7/8" x 1"

• Patterned paper strips: 3 1/2" x 1/4"

Instructions:

- Texture the Pool Party layer using the Tin Tile Embossing Folder adhere to the Blackberry Bliss layer
- Cut the strips adhere the Galvanized Metallic strip in place. Cut a V in one end of each
 patterned strip using sharp scissors or the Banner Triple Punch and layer on top, slightly
 staggering them
- Cut a piece of Chicken Wire Elements and adhere on top of the patterned strips
- Wrap around a piece of Braided Linen Trim and secure on the back of the Blackberry layer.
- Adhere these layers to the Early Espresso card base
- Stamp the jug and flowers onto white cardstock and use the largest oval die in Layering Ovals Framelits to cut it out color using various Stampin' Blends Markers
- Add glitter to the blue flower using the Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Brush and add a Rhinestone Jewel to the center
- Add the oval to the card base using Dimensionals
- Tie a bow of Linen Thread to the Braided Linen Trim next to the oval shape and there you have one pretty card ready for any occasion!
