Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Falling For Leaves 147680, Buffalo Check 147794/147797
- Bundle: Falling For Leaves 149938
- Inks: Granny Apple Green 147095, Crushed Curry 147087, Pumpkin Pie 147086, Mossy Meadow 147111, Rich Razzleberry 147091, Blackberry Bliss 147092
- Cardstock: Granny Apple Green 146990, Crushed Curry 131199, Pumpkin Pie 105117, Mossy Meadow 133676, Rich Razzleberry 115316, Blackberry Bliss 133675, Whisper White 100730
- Accessories: 3/16" Braided Linen Trim 147808, Gold Library Clips 144130
- Tools: Detailed Leaves Thinlits Dies 147921, Large Letters 141712, Detailed Baubles Thinlits Dies 147924, Foam Adhesive Strips 141825, Detailed Trio Punch 146320, Aqua Painter 103954, Paper Snips 103579

INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Using Granny Apple Green, Rich Razzleberry, Pumpkin Pie, Mossy Meadow, Crushed Curry and Blackberry Bliss Cardstocks, cut (1) of each color to measure 5" x 3-3/4".



2. Ink the Buffalo Check stamp image to each cardstock piece by using the coordinating ink color. This is easier if you flip the stamp image side up, ink and press the cardstock in place over the stamp image. Use a piece of scrap paper over the cardstock and press over the cardstock piece to transfer the image.



3. Cut each cardstock piece into a banner by using Paper Snips on one short end.





4. Cut out (3) doilies from the Detailed Baubles Thinlits Dies using Whisper White Cardstock. Cut each doily in half. (Note: You will need two dies to cut both pieces). Glue $\frac{1}{2}$ of each doily to the left side of each banner.



5. Cut out the letters F-A-L-L using the Large Letters Dies. I used Crushed Curry for the "F", Granny Apple Green for the "A", Blackberry Bliss for the "L" and Pumpkin Pie for the "L". Add Foam Adhesive Strips to the back of each letter and glue one letter to four of the doilies.



6. Stamp one large leaf image in each ink color using Whisper White Cardstock. As you stamp each leaf, take the Aqua Painter and color the leaves using the inked lines. Cut out each leaf with the coordinating die.





7. Cut an assortment of die-cut leaves from the die set, in all cardstock colors and glue all of the layers around the letters in clusters. Two banners will not have letters on them.



8. Use the Detailed Trio Punch to add two holes at the top of each banner. Thread the ribbon trim through the holes and tie off the ends into a loop. Add a Gold Library Clip at the top of each banner to hold the ribbon trim in place on the back of each banner.
