

Halloween Treat Holder Purse By Twila Davis





Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:


- Stamps: Cauldron Bubble
- Inks: Memento Black
- Cardstock: Crushed Curry, Pumpkin Pie, Whisper White
- Designer Paper: (DSP) Toil & Trouble
- Accessories: Black 3/8" Glittered Organdy Ribbon, Metal Rimmed Pearls (Clearance Rack)
- Tools: Stampin' Trimmer, Simply Scored Tool, Big Shot, Cauldron Framelit Dies, Paper Snips, Pretty Label Punch
- Miscellaneous: Tear Taper, Glue Dots, Window Sheets, Basic Black Dark and Light Stampin' Blends, Pumpkin Pie Dark Stampin' Blends, Halloween Hershey Kisses*, *(The Halloween Kisses are a bit bigger than the regular ones, allowing only 3 to fit, but when using the regular ones 4 will fit)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a piece of DSP 6" x 6". Score at 1 1/4" & 4 3/4". Turn 45 degrees and score at 2 1/2" & 3 1/2". Also cut (2) 1 1/4" x 3" pieces of matching DSP.



2. Crease all scorelines. Fold making a right angle on the sides where the scorelines meet. Do not crease all of the angle but just from the top of the paper to where the scorelines meet. Flip the paper and do it on the other side as well.



3. It will look like this when you are done.



4. Adhere the two patching strips of DSP in the middle of the top and bottom of the 6" x 6" piece. Add 1 1/8" pieces of Tear Tape to each inside corner by fold at top and bottom.



5. Cut (2) pieces of the Black Ribbon 6" long. Peel of the Tear Tape backing and add ribbons as shown. Fold over end flaps. As you fold the purse up the sides will crease in forming a pocket.



6. Bring both sides up to form your purse. Cut (2) 3/4" x 3 1/2" pieces of Crushed Curry and adhere to the top front and back. Using the Pretty Label Punch and Crushed Curry, punch a label out then score in the middle and adhere to the back of the purse making your closure flap. Add a Velcro Dot to the underneath side of the front of the label flap and front of purse.



7. Stamp images using Memento Black and then diet. Color the cat using the Blend Markers. Stamp "Trick or Treat" in Memento Black onto a 3/4" by 1 1/2" scrap of Pumpkin Pie CS. Using the Paper Snips make the stamped piece into a banner.



8. Cut a 1/4" strip of Window Sheet 2" long and another 1 3/4" long. Attach one of each to a Hershey Kiss and a ghost using Glue Dots. Remaining ghost adhere to Hershey Kiss with a Glue Dot.



9. Cut a 1/2" by 2 3/4" strip of Crushed Curry and stamp "Happy Halloween" on it and adhere to inside top of purse. Adhere a ghost to the right hand side of it. Place the Hershey Kisses w/ attached ghost inside the purse.



10. Adhere the Black cat to the right hand side of the little Banner and add a few stars. Fasten it to the top right hand side of the purse just below the Ribbon handle using Tear Tape. Make a Black Ribbon Bow and attach to the Ribbon handle. Color a medium sized Metal Rimmed Pearl with the Dark Black Blend and adhere it to the Label Flap.



11. Congratulations! Your purse is now complete. This pattern is cute made up in any color of DSP and is a wonderful way to use up those 6" x 6" pieces you have laying around. Any questions can be emailed to me at tjdstampsalot@yahoo.com. Happy Crafting!
