Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Spooky Sweets (CM 147716/WM 147719)

BUNDLE: Spooky Sweets Bundle (CM 149973/WM 149974)

Cardstocks: Black Foil Sheets (147898), Whisper White (100730), Basic Black (121045), Pumpkin Pie

(105117), Crushed Curry (131199)

DSP: Toil & Trouble (147531)

Die Cutting & Embossing: Swirls & Curls Embossing Folder (147923), Stitched Shapes Framelits

(145372), Big Shot (143263)

Punches: Spooky Bats (148014), (Pretty Label (143715), 1" Circle (119868), 1 1/4" Circle (119861),

1/8" Circle (134365)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Twine: Basic Black Solid Bakers Twine (141682)

Tools: Simply Scored (122334), Paper Snips (103579)

Misc: Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Dimensionals (144108),

Tear & Tape (138995), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Hershey Nuggets

INSTRUCTIONS:

Slide out drawer – cut a piece of cardstock at 11" x 3 3/4"



Place into your scoring tool with one of the long edges along the top – score down at 1/2" and 1 1/8"



Repeat for the other end...



Now place the first short edge along the top of your scoring tool and score down at 1/2" and 1 1/8"



Repeat for the other end



And now you will have score lines on all sides that intersect like this...



Use sharp scissors to cut along the score lines to create tabs...



Cut and shape the tabs as shown below – this makes for easier folding...



Fold along all score lines...



Apply strips of Tear & Tape to the tabs...



Peel off the backing strip and fold and adhere the tabs in place...



Once done, this is what you will have – one finished slide out drawer...



Box cover – cut a piece of cardstock to be 8 7/8" x 7"



Put into your scoring tool with one of the shorter edges along the top and you are going to make 5 score lines down -3/4" 23/8" 31/8" 43/4" 51/2"



Fold along all score lines...



Apply strong adhesive tape to the 3/4" flap...



Peel off backing tape and adhere in place, being careful to keep it square as you do it...



Slide your drawer in...



And here it is all closed up – and now for the fun bit – decorating!



To cover the nuggets – take your patterned paper and cut into $1" \times 3"$ strips – wrap each around a nugget and secure on the back using tape...



This is how I decorated – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:
