



Die & Punch Art Reindeer Ghirardelli Treat Holder



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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Dashing Deer (147728,147731)
- Inks: Poppy Parade (147050), Journaling Pens (145480)
- Cardstock: Early Espresso (119686), Whisper White (100730), Poppy Parade (119793), Call Me Clover (146969)
- Accessories: Red Rhinestone Jewels (146924)
- Tools: ½" Circle Punch (119869), ¾" Circle Punch (119873), 1-3/8" Scallop Circle Punch (146139), Tailored Tag Punch (145667), ¼" Handheld Punch, Detailed Leaves Thinlits Dies (147921), Layering Ovals Dies (141706), Layering Circles Dies (141705), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Dimensionals (144108), Multipurpose Glue (110755), Simply Scored Scoring Tool (122334), Paper Snips (103579), Sponge Dauber (133733), Detailed Deer Thinlits Dies (147915), Wink Of Stella (141897)


INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Cut a piece of Early Espresso Cardstock to measure 10-1/4" x 4".
 - a. On the 4" side, score at 1" and 3".
 - b. On the 10-1/4" side, score at 3", 4".
 - c. Staying on the 10-1/4" side, score at 7" up to the 1" score line.
 - d. Staying on the 10-1/4" side, score at 8-1/2" in the center only.
 - e. Score and fold on all score lines
 - f. Cut using Paper Snips on the red lines shown on the pattern below to create tabs
 - g. Cut away the two black squares as shown on the pattern



2. Add adhesive to the two small tabs in the center. Fold over to the inside of the box and press one long tab on each side to form the sides.



3. Add adhesive to the two remaining tabs and press in place over the first tabs to form the box shape.



This is what the box should look like so far.



4. Using the scallop punch, cut (1) using Early Espresso Cardstock. Cut two pieces using the $\frac{3}{4}$ " Circle Punch as shown in photo 2 & 3. These are the paws.



5. Use a Sponge Dauber and the Early Espresso Ink to sponge along all edges of the box and the two pieces cut for the paws.



6. Add a Velcro Dot under the flap and on the front of the box for the closure.



7. Stamp and cut the following for the front of the box:

- a. Cut a piece of Whisper White Cardstock to measure 3-1/4" x 3/4". Stamp the sentiment in the center using Poppy Parade Ink. Trim the two ends using the Tailored Tag Punch as shown in photo 2. Glue the banner in place on the front of the box using Stampin' Dimensionals about 1/2" from the bottom
- b. Glue the two paws above the sentiment using Mini Dimensionals. Position them both so they look like they are holding the banner.
- c. Using the Detailed Deer Dies, cut (2) of the swirly die using Call Me Clover Cardstock and glue under the banner at the bottom. Cut (3) of the flowers using Poppy Parade Cardstock. Glue the flowers in place over the swirls.
- d. Add Red Rhinestones to the center of each flower.



8. Cut the following for the reindeer head:

- a. (1) circle using Early Espresso Cardstock and the Layering Circles Die that measures 2-1/8".
 - b. (1) oval using Early Espresso Cardstock and the Layering Ovals Dies that measures 2-3/4" wide
 - c. (2) leaves using Early Espresso Cardstock and the Detailed Leaves Dies
 - d. (1) circle using Poppy Parade Cardstock and the 3/4" Circle Punch
 - e. (2) circles using Whisper White Cardstock and the 1/2" Circle Punch
 - f. (2) circles using Basic Black Cardstock and the 1/4" Handheld Punch
9. Sponge Early Espresso Ink around the edges of all Early Espresso Cardstock pieces with the Sponge Dauber and the Early Espresso Ink.



10. Glue the two leaves for ears on the large circle and then glue the circle to the box flap making sure to cover the flap at the very top. Trim the two corners on the bottom of the flap at an angle.



11. Glue the Poppy Parade circle to the oval for the nose and color the nose with Clear Wink Of Stella.
12. Glue the oval to the flap of the box, making sure to cover the bottom of the flap.
13. Glue the two white and two black circles for the eyes by tucking them under the oval.
14. Add two white dots in each eyeball using a white pen.



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
