



Mini Calendar Purse

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Cardstock: Blueberry Bushel
- Designer Paper: Garden Impressions 6" x 6"
- Accessories: Metal Rimmed Pearls (retired)
- Tools: Big Shot, Layering Ovals Framelites, Tufted Embossing Folder, Paper Trimmer, Detailed Trio Punch, Mono Liquid Glue
- Miscellaneous: Magnetic Strip, Medium Calendar (1 3/4" x 2 3/8"), Scrap of cardboard backing from a pack of DSP

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut (2) 3" x 3" squares of Blueberry Bushel CS, and (1) 3" x 3" square of cardboard backing. Run (1) of the Blueberry squares through the Big Shot using the Tufted Embossing Folder. Round the 2 bottom corners of each square piece using the Detailed Trio Punch.



2. Cut a piece of the Garden Impressions DSP to 1 1/2" x 3" and cut out with the Layering Ovals Framelits for the purse flap. Run it through the Big Shot using the Tufted Embossing Folder. Using the largest scallop oval and one of the regular ovals (one that will give you about a 3/8" width), cut out an oval. This is your purse handle. Tip: The Oval Framelit used for the purse flap fits in-between the two you will use for the purse handle.



3. Glue the purse handle to the back of the square cardboard piece. Then attach back Blueberry square and add a 2" magnetic strip as shown.



4. Attach the (back) Blueberry Bushel square and add a 2" magnetic strip as shown.



5. Flip the purse over to the front and glue on the (tufted front) square of Blueberry Bushel, Lay down DSP purse flap and calendar on purse front and check for placement. You may need to trim the flap a little more. Glue down flap and adhere calendar in place. Add an embellishment of your choice to center of flap. Your Mini Calendar Purse is now complete.
