Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: NoneInks: None

• Cardstock: Whisper White (100730), Lemon Lime Twist (144245)

• Designer Paper: Festive Farmhouse (147820)

- Accessories: Red Rhinestone Jewels (146924), Festive Farmhouse Cotton Twine (147888), Festive Farmhouse Elements (147890)
- Tools: Farmhouse Framelits Dies (147922), Stitched Shapes Framelits Dies (145372), Simply Scored (122334), Iridescent Boxwood Wreaths Embellishments (147803), Multipurpose Glue (110755), Tear & Tape (138995), Snail Adhesive (104332), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108), Mini Glue Dots (103683) Paper Snips (103579)
- Miscellaneous: (6) Hershey's Miniature Chocolate Bars

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **BOX BOTTOM:** Cut a piece of Whisper White Cardstock to measure 6" x 5-1/2". Score at $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1" on all four sides:



2. Using Paper Snips, trim off each corner as shown in photo 1. Snip across to create a tab when removing the sections shown. Cut the two sides of the tab at an angle and cut the large bottom tab at an angle. You can see the angle cuts in photo 2:





- 3. Add liquid glue to the one end with the small flaps and fold the end flap over.
- 4. Add glue to the small tabs and glue to the inside of the opposite side to create the box shape. Repeat on the other side.





5. Add glue to the two remaining flaps on each end and fold over. You should now have a four-side box bottom.





- 6. **BOX TOP:** Cut a piece of Festive Farmhouse Designer Paper to measure 6-1/8" x 5-5/8". Score at $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1" on all four sides:
- 7. Cut the ends, flaps and angles like you did in Step 1 for the box bottom:



- 8. Glue the sides of the box top like you did for the box bottom.
- 9. Add a rolled-up Mini Glue Dot centered on each side corner of the box top. Wrap twine around the box top and press the twine on the glue dot on each corner. Tie the front into a bow:



10. Cut six strips of the Festive Farmhouse Designer Paper to measure 3" x 1-1/2". Add Tear & Tape to one end and remove backing. Wrap around each chocolate bar, overlapping the ends and pressing in place to glue. Place the chocolate bars inside the box bottom and add the lid to the top of the box:





11. Cut an oval using the Stitched Shapes Framelits Dies oval that measures 3-1/4" wide and the Festive Farmhouse Designer Paper. Glue to the top of the lid:



- 12. You will need the following to decorate the top of the box lid:
 - a. (2) snowshoes cut with the Farmhouse Framelits Dies and Whisper White Cardstock
 - b. (2) of the holly leaves die from the Farmhouse Framelits Dies using Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock. I used 5 holly leaves total
 - c. The word "merry" and (5) stars from the Festive Farmhouse Elements
 - d. Red Rhinestone Jewels
 - e. (1) Iridescent Boxwood Wreath Embellishment
 - f. (1) bow using the Festive Farmhouse Cotton Twine.

Glue all of the elements to the box top as shown in these four photos:





Layer and glue the snowshoes to each other. Insert wreath from the top of the snowshoes. I then used Mini Dimensionals under the snowshoes to glue them in place.
