

Butterfly Box Card By Twila Davis



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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Butterfly Gala, Treat Time, Part Of My Story (Saleabration)
- Inks: Memento Black
- Cardstock: Daffodil Delight, Whisper White, Basic Black, Window Sheets, small scrap of Grapefruit Grove
- Designer Paper: Botanical Butterfly Paper (Saleabration), Gingham Gala 6" x 6" Designer Pack
- Accessories: Black Metallic Thread (retired)
- Tools: Stampin' Trimmer, Punches: Butterfly Duet, 1 1/4"Circle, 1 3/8"Scallop Circle, Cookie Cutter Builder, Big Shot, Stitched Framelit Dies, Rectangle Stitched Framelit Dies, Layering Oval Framelit Dies, Paper Snips
- Miscellaneous: Snail, Glue Dots, Dimensionals

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a piece of Daffodil Delight CS at 4" x 7". Score on the long side at 1 1/2" and 5 1/2". Turn and score on the short side at 2 1/4". The top flaps of the box will be the part that measures 1 3/4". Cut on scorelines down to where it intersects with other scoreline. Cut a piece of Daffodil Delight CS 4" x 5". On the long side score at 1/2" and 4 1/2". Measure down 1 3/4" from top, make a mark and cut on shorelines and across on mark.



2. Cut (3) pieces of Daffodil Delight Gingham - (1) at $1 \frac{9}{16}$ " x $3 \frac{13}{16}$ " and (2) at $1 \frac{5}{16}$ x $1 \frac{9}{16}$ ". Adhere to top flaps.



3. Cut a piece of Botanical Butterfly Garden (small butterflies) at 3 13/16" x 3 13/16" and adhere to second piece of Daffodil Delight CS.



4. Attach the pieces of Cardstock together adding adhesive one of the back flaps.



5. Add adhesive to other flap and fold to meet other end to close up box. (When card is complete it will still fold down for easy mailing.)



6. Fold top flaps done. It will look like this.



7. Cut a piece of Daffodil Delight 1 1/2" x 4 3/4". Score on the long side at 3/8" and 4 3/8". Add adhesive to side tabs, fold and insert into box dividing it in half longways and adhere to both sides.



8. Using the Big Shot and the Layering Oval Thinlet Die that is approximately 3" wide, cut out a Basic black Scallop Oval. Stamp "Hello Beautiful" onto a piece of Whisper White CS and cut out using the Big Shot and the Stitched Shaped Oval Framelit that measures 2 1/2". Punch out a 1 3/8" Scallop Circle using Basic Black CS, Stamp "Happy Birthday" (covering up the top and bottom squiggles with a piece of tape) onto a piece of Whisper White CS and punch out with the 1 1/4" Circle Punch.



9. Using your Paper Snips cut out some of the big and small butterflies from the Botanical Butterfly Garden DSP. Punch them out with the Butterfly Duet Punch. Adding a piece of Post -a-note to them may help to align them in the punch.



10. Cut a 2" piece of Black Metalic Thread and add to the backs of (3) large butterflies with a glue dot and cover with a small scrap of Whisper White CS. Cut a piece of Window Sheet 1/4" x 12". Cut this down to 2 1/2" and attach to the backside also with a Glue Dot.



11. Attach the sayings to the Basic Black backgrounds with Dimensionals and adhere to box as shown, being careful not to go above the box more than 1/4". Start adding butterflies by adding big ones first. Add one to the butterfly paper with a Dimensional and one to the inside front with adhesive. Add the middle one that is on a Window Sheet stem to the backside of the divider piece with a Glue Dot.



12. Stamp image from Stamp set Part Of My Story onto Whisper White CS and cut out using the Rectangle Stitched Framelit Die that measures 1 3/8" x 3 3/8". Punch out a Grapefruit Grove Heart using the Cookie Cutter Builder Punch and attach to the saying covering up the black heart.



13. On the back of your box adhere the saying to the lower middle and add a butterfly.



14. Keep adding small butterflies to the frontside of your box using adhesive, Dimensionals, or Window Sheet Strips until completed. The finished box will look something like this.
