



## Pillow Box Cake Pouch Holder

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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Coffee Cafe (143677), Birthday Banners (141506)

Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Early Espresso (119686)

Die Cutting & Embossing: Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Wood Crate Framelits (143730), Softly Falling Embossing Folder (139672), Big Shot (143263)

Punches: Decorative Ribbon Border (143721), 1/2" Circle (119869)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114), Poppy Parade (147050)

Ribbon & Twine: Poppy Parade 1/2" Textured Weave (147813)

Misc: Kraft Pillow Box (147018), Corrugated Elements (144158), Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801), Paper Snips (103579), Tear & Tape (138995), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Single Serving Size Chocolate Cake Pouch

**Stamp your tag:** I took a stamp that said ‘happiness is a cup of coffee shared with a friend’ from the set Coffee Café and wanted to leave the word ‘coffee’ out to get this stamped image...



If you've not done this before, all you need is a roll of masking tape and this is how you do it...

I covered the word 'coffee' with pieces of masking tape & inked it up...



Then I peeled off the masking tape and stamped down onto my cardstock...



And voila – here is your stamped image without the word ‘coffee’!



I then stamped the word ‘cake’ using a stamp from Birthday Banners – you can use scissors or a paper trimmer to simply make a rectangle around it or...



Like I did, fussy cut the word out...





**Alter the Pillow Box:** take your pillow box...



And use your paper trimmer to cut a very thin piece off of one of the long edges...



See the notch? It's only on one side but you want it to be on both...



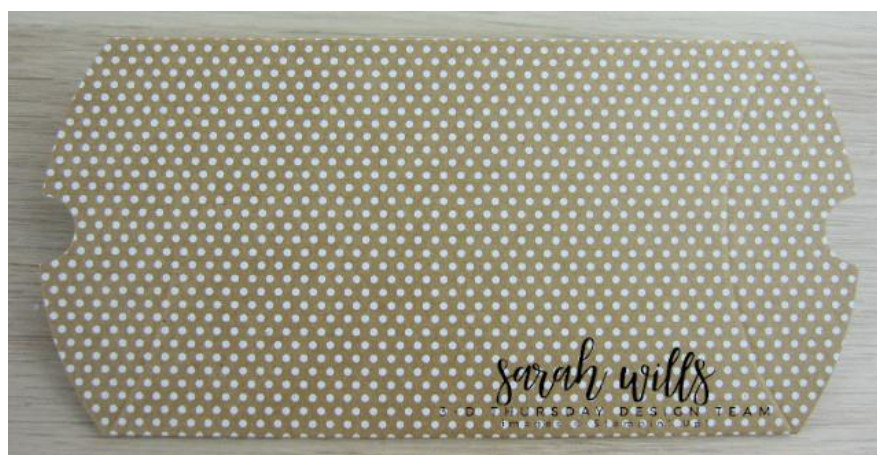
Take a 1/2" Circle Punch, line it up over the notch and punch to get the same cut shape on the piece below...



Repeat at the other end...



And now you are ready for assembly...





Add decoration to the top open edges using a border punch – I choose the Decorative Ribbon Punch...



Cut two pieces and adhere in place...



Take your Cake Pouch Mix and position, securing with a piece of Sticky Strip to hold it in place...



Fold the front piece over...



And use a piece of ribbon to tie around the pillow box through those notches to get a nice snug fit...



Adhere your stamped panel in place using Dimensionals and add bling to your heart's desire!
