## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Cardstock: Lovely Lipstick
- Designer Paper: All My Love (Occasions Catalog)
- Tools: Stampin' Trimmer, Big Shot, Large Letters Framelits, Be Mine Stitched Framelits (Occasions Catalog), Paper Snips
- Miscellaneous: (4) Wood Stamp Blocks, Pearls, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Mod Podge, Foam Brush, White Wash or Paint

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. You will need (2) Wood Blocks 2" x 3", (1) Block 2 1/4" x 2 1/2", & (1) Block 2 1/2" x 2 3/4". These blocks can be new or reclaimed ones that have had the stamps taken off. Clean as good as possible, but know that the DSP will cover up any residue left on front or back of blocks.



2. Using Block measurements from (Step 1) cut (2) pieces of Flowered DSP with Brown background a bit smaller and Mod Podge to the front and back of each block. When dry add a top coat of Mod Podge to front and back of the blocks.



3. Using White Wash or Paint, cover the sides and tops and bottoms of blocks.



4. Using Lovely Lipstick CS cut out the letters L V E using the Big Shot and Large Letters Framelits and also a heart from the Be Mine Stitched Framelits. Adhere to the Wooden Blocks with Mod Podge. After dry add a top coat. Cut out some flowers and petals from the left over DSP and add a coat of Mod Podge to the top of the pieces. After dry adhere to the letters and heart as shown using glue. Add pearls for accents. Your project is now complete.
