## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Bloom by Bloom (148820), All That You Are (148664), Butterfly Gala (148580), Here Comes

The Sun (148793) **Bundles**: Butterfly Gala (150599), Bloom by Bloom (150598)

**Die Cutting & Embossing**: Stitched Rectangles Framelits (148551), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Subtles Dynamic EF (143706), Big Shot (143263)

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Whisper White (100730), Garden Green (102584), Crumb Cake (120953), Melon Mambo (115320)

DSP: Delightfully Detailed Laser Cut Specialty (146907), Happiness Blooms (148795)

**Punches**: 1" Circle (119868), Decorative Ribbon Border (143721), Leaf (144667), Bitty Blooms (148532)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114), Melon Mambo (147051), Garden Green (147089), Pumpkin Pie (147086)

**Misc**: Paper Snips (103579), Crumb Cake 3/8" Classic Weave (144162), Basic Rhinestone Jewels (144220), Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332), Tear & Tape (138995), Packet of Seeds

Take a piece of cardstock in the color of your choice and cut it to be  $4" \times 11"$  – the seed packet that I used is sized  $4 \cdot 1/2" \times 3 \cdot 1/4"$  - if you have a taller seed packet you will want to use 12" long cardstock and if your packet is wider you can add to your width too.

Place into your scoring tool with the longest edge along the top and make three score lines: at  $4\,3/4$ ",  $9\,1/2$ " and  $9\,5/8$ "



## Fold along all score lines



To get a nice crisp fold when you have two folds very close together I fold the first and then I like to use a ruler to help fold the second – simply butt it up to the score line and gently ease the cardstock up towards it



This helps get that fold in the correct place so that it is accurate



Fold up your card with the small flap to hold the seed packet tucked inside – trim away 1/4" at the bottom of the front panel so that you have a little of the bottom panel showing



Put a strip of strong adhesive tape on each side of the inside of the flap, as close to the edges as possible so that you can fit your seed packet in there...



Secure in place and make sure your seed packet fits...



And now for the fun bit – decorating! This is how I decorated mine – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:
