

## **BUNNY TINY TREAT BOX**

## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:


- Inks: Highland Heather
- Cardstock: (CS) Whisper White, Basic Black, Highland Heather
- Designer Paper: Gingham Gala
- Accessories: Highland Heather Organza Ribbon (SAB retired)
- Tools: Paper Trimmer, 1/2", 3/4" 1" Circle Punches, 1 1//8" Scallop Circle Punch, Heart Punch (retired), Big Shot, Layer Oval Framelits, White Stampin' Chalk Marker, Stampin Sponge, Dimensionals, Tear Tape, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Mini Glue Dots
- Miscellaneous: Clear Tiny Treat Box, Jelly Beans

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Assemble a Clear Tiny Treat Box and fill with Jelly Beans or other treat. Cut a piece of Whisper White CS to 2" x 8 1/2". Crease around the box starting at one corner. You will end up with a 1/2" flap left. Take off the CS and make the creases into folds. Add a piece of Tear Tape to the 1/2" flap.




2. Punch the following (2) 1" circles using punch and Whisper White CS, (1) 1 1/8" scallop circle using Whisper White CS and punch, (1) 1/2" circle using Highland Heather and punch, (2) 1/2" circles using Basic Black and punch, (1) heart using Highland Heather and punch. Using the Big Shot and Layering Ovals diet (2) Gingham ovals using the smallest Oval Framelits, and diecut (2) Whisper White ovals using the next to the smallest Oval Framelits. Sponge around each punched piece except the Basic Black ones. Using the White Chalk Marker add highlights to the Basic Black circles.



3. Wrap the CS back around the box and attach using the Tear Tape. (Make sure that the opening flap of the box is to the back.) Using a sponge and the Highland Heather Ink sponge all edges of the CS. Start building your bunny. Overlap the two 1" circles and attach the heart to the top of them with glue. Add Dimensionals to the back of the grouping and add to the front of the box as shown.



4. Attach the pieces of the ears together as shown with glue.



5. Attach the rest of the bunny face pieces with glue. Add the paws to the bottom of the front. Add ears to the inside Whisper White box cover. Attach a bow to the base of the left ear with a Mini Glue Dot. Add the scallop circle to the bottom of the back of the bunny and you are done!
