



Mini Pizza Box filled with Mini Notecards

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: To A Wild Rose (149452), Itty Bitty Greetings (146667)

BUNDLE: To a Wild Rose (151073)

Die Cutting & Embossing: Wild Rose (149547), Pinewood Planks (143708), Big Shot (143263)

Cardstocks: Crumb Cake (120953), Soft Suede (115318), Very Vanilla (101650), Vellum (101856), Champagne Foil (144748)

Punches: Leaf (144667), Classic Label (141491)

Inks: Crumb Cake (147116), Soft Suede (147115), Rococo Rose (150080), Pool Party (147107), Old Olive (147090)

Ribbon & Twine: 5/8" Burlap (141487), 1/4" Mint Macaron Textile Ribbon (149480), Linen Thread (104199)

Misc: Mini Pizza Boxes (144645), Whisper White 3x3 Envelopes (145829), Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801), Wink of Stella Clear Glitter (141897), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Take a Mini Pizza Box and fold together to assemble. Cut a piece of Soft Suede cardstock to measure 3 1/4" square and adhere to the lid.

Apply Crumb Cake Ink to one inside surface of the Pinewood Planks Embossing Folder and pop in a piece of Crumb Cake cardstock – run through your die cutting machine – allow to dry and cut to measure 3 1/8" square and adhere onto the Soft Suede square.

Ink and emboss another piece and cut into 1" strips – adhere around the sides of the box.

Stamp 'hello' directly into the lower right corner.

Create a belly band – wrap a piece of Burlap Ribbon around the pizza box and cut to size finishing on the bottom of the box – use a Velcro dot to secure the ends together to allow it to be easily removed.

Use the floral lacey die to cut a piece out of Vellum cardstock and adhere onto the Burlap Ribbon – tie around a piece of Mint Macaron Textile Ribbon and finish with a bow on the front.

Stamp the flower using Rococo Rose & Soft Suede Inks and die cut out using a die from Wild Rose – add some Clear Wink of Stella Glitter to the flower center and use Dimensionals to adhere onto the Burlap.

Stamp the leaves with Old Olive & Soft Suede Inks, die cut out and adhere under the flower directly onto the box lid.

Die cut more leaves from Champagne Foil and adhere in place and add a Clear Epoxy Droplet above the flower.



Make cards to fill the box – six fit nicely into the box with their envelopes – cut a piece of cardstock to measure 6" x 3" and score halfway at 3" – then decorate as wished – here are mine:
