

## COLOR FUSERS JULY 2019 COLOR CHALLENGE CARD

### Supplies:

**Stamps:** Soft Spring (149429), Free As a Bird (149468)

**Cardstocks:** Purple Posy (150881), Whisper White (100730), Crumb Cake (120953)

**Embossing:** Scripty 3D Embossing Folder (149634), 3D Embossing Folder Plate (149658)

**Die Cutting:** Stitched Nested Labels Dies (149638)

**Blends Markers:** Purple Posy Dark (149565), Seaside Spray Light (149567), Seaside Spray Dark (149568), Crumb Cake Light (144582)

**Ink:** Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Soft Sea Foam (147102)

**Ribbon & Twine:** Purple Posy 1/2" Scalloped Linen Ribbon (149706), Linen Thread (104199)

**Misc:** Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

### Cutting Measurements:

**Card base:** Purple Posy - 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

**Layer:** Whisper White - 4" x 5 1/4"

**Layer 2:** Crumb Cake - 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

## Instructions:

- Cut your Purple Posy card base & adhere the Whisper White layer on top
- Cut the Crumb Cake layer and emboss using your die cutting machine and the Scripty 3D Embossing Folder – *please note that you will also need the 3D Embossing Folder plate as a shim if using a Big Shot to do this* – then adhere onto the white layer
- Use the largest die in Stitched Nested Labels Dies to cut out a Purple Posy shape – adhere onto the Crumb Cake layer
- Wrap around a piece of Purple Posy Scalloped Linen Ribbon and tape in place where the white stamped panel will go on top of it for a seamless look
- Use the plant stamp from Soft Spring and Memento Tuxedo Ink to stamp your feature – die cut out using the next sized die down from Stitched Nested Labels
- Use the coordinating leaves stamp & Soft Sea Foam Ink to stamp the leaves in place and Stampin Blends Markers to color the flowers & soil – when done, adhere this shaped layer in place using Stampin Dimensionals
- Stamp the dragonfly and color using Stampin Blends – you can either shape it using a circle punch or fussy cut it out – use a little bit of a Dimensional to adhere in place
- Cut a length of Linen Thread and circle it a few times – use tape to pinch it in the center to hold the shape and adhere to your card
- Stamp the sentiment of your choice and cut it out using a smaller Stitched Nested Labels Die and use Dimensionals to adhere in place over the Linen Thread
- Pop a few Frosted Epoxy Droplets or Jewels onto your card and voila – one beautiful card that you can theme for any occasion simply by changing the sentiment 😊
