## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Gather Together (150589), Country Home (147678)
- Bundle: Gather Together (153036)
- Inks: Cajun Craze (147085), Pear Pizzazz (1147104), Pretty Peacock (1150083), Rich Razzleberry (147091)
- Cardstock: Cajun Craze (119684, Pear Pizzazz (131201), Pretty Peacock (150880), Rich Razzleberry (115316), Whisper White (100730), Vellum (101856)
- Designer Paper: Come To Gather (150454)
- Accessories: Linen Thread (104199), Pretty Peacock ½" Scallop Linen Ribbon (149751), Noble Peacock Rhinestones (149494), Tags & Feathers Elements (150455)
- Tools: Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Pretty Label Punch (143715), Gathered Leaves Dies (150662), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Layering Circles Dies (141705), Leaf Punch (144667), Sprig Punch (148012), Hammered Metal Embossing Folder (150646), Blender Pen (102845)
- Miscellaneous: 12" x 12" frame, Designer Paper Cardboard Backing

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

## Step #1:

Using Pretty Peacock Cardstock, cut (8) pieces to measure 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" and (1) piece to measure 3-1/4" x 6-5/8". Set aside.



Step #2: Square #1

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3" x 3". Glue to a Pretty Peacock Cardstock square.

Stamp the sentiment from the Country Home stamp set using Rich Razzleberry Ink on a piece of Whisper White Cardstock that measures 3" x 1". Glue to the designer paper layer about 1/4" from the bottom.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the white layer in the background.



Step #3: Square #2

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3" x 3". Glue to a Pretty Peacock Cardstock square.

Using the dies, cut out (3) leaf sizes using Pear Pizzazz, Cajun Craze and Pretty Peacock Cardstocks. Glue the largest leaf using Stampin' Dimensionals to the designer paper. Glue the two other leaves on top of the Pear Pizzazz leaf. Glue two of the feathers on top

of the leaves. Using the ribbon, tie into a knot and trim both ends at an angle. Glue to the feathers using Mini Glue Dots.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the background.



Step 4: Square #3

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3" x 3". Glue to a Pretty Peacock Cardstock square.

Cut a  $2^{nd}$  piece of Designer Paper with a different pattern to measure 3" x 1" and glue about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom of the  $1^{st}$  Designer Paper pattern.

Stamp the leaf image on Whisper White Cardstock using Cajun Craze Ink. Quickly use the stamped ink lines and a Blender Pen to add color to the leaf and cut out with the die. Glue to the front of the Designer Paper using Stampin' Dimensionals. Tie the Linen Thread into a bow and glue to the leaf using Mini Glue Dots.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the background.



Step 5: Square #4

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3" x 3". Glue to a Pretty Peacock Cardstock square.

Using the dies, cut (1) large leaf using Rich Razzleberry Cardstock and emboss using the Hammered Metal Embossing Folder. Glue to the designer paper using Stampin' Dimensionals. Cut out (1) smaller leaf using

Cajun Craze Cardstock, (1) sprig with the Sprig Punch and Whisper White Cardstock and (1) leaf using the Leaf Punch with Pear Pizzazz Cardstock and (1) with Vellum Cardstock. Glue all of the layers over the Rich Razzleberry leaf. Glue one feather to the leaves and add a bow using Linen Thread and Mini Glue Dots.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the background.



Step 6: Square #5

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3" x 3". Glue to a Pretty Peacock Cardstock square.

Stamp the sentiment from the Gather Together stamp set using Pretty Peacock Ink on Whisper White Cardstock and cut out using the Pretty Label Punch. Glue to the Designer Paper about ½" from the top.

Cut out (2) pumpkins from the Designer Paper and glue to the Designer Paper below the sentiment using Stampin' Dimensionals. Glue a feather by tucking it under the pumpkin.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the background.



Step 7: Square #6

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3" x 3". Set aside.

Cut out several leaves using the three smaller leaf dies and Pear Pizzazz Cardstock. Glue the die-cut leaves to the whole background of the Designer Paper. Trim the leaves even to the edges of the Designer Paper. Glue to a Pretty Peacock Cardstock square.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the background.



Step 8: Square #7

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3"  $\times$  6-3/8". Glue a strip of the Pretty Peacock Ribbon about  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top. Glue the Designer Paper layer to the largest Pretty Peacock Cardstock layer.

Cut out (2) leaves with the largest leaf die and Rich Razzleberry Cardstock. Glue to the bottom and side-by-side with the stem facing towards the top. Stamp (3) leaves using the leaf image in Pear Pizzazz, Cajun Craze and Pretty Peacock Inks on Whisper White Cardstock. Quickly use the stamped ink lines and a Blender Pen to add color to each leaf. Cut out with the die and glue each leaf in place over the Rich Razzleberry leaves using Stampin' Dimensionals. Cut out (2) leaves using Vellum Cardstock and the Leaf Punch. Glue and tuck the Vellum leaves in amongst the stamped leaves.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the background.



Step 9: Square #8

Cut a piece of the Come To Gather Designer Paper to measure 3" x 3". Glue to a Pretty Peacock Cardstock square.

Stamp the sentiment from the Country Home stamp set on Whisper White using Cajun Craze Ink. Cut with the Layering Circles Dies that measures 2-1/2" and glue to the Designer Paper using Stampin' Dimensionals. Cut out

leaves using the leaf Punch, (2) with Pear Pizzazz Cardstock and (1) with Vellum Cardstock. Glue to the bottom right of the circle with the stems at the top. Using the ribbon, tie into a knot and trim both ends at an angle. Glue to the leaves using Mini Glue Dots.

Add Rhinestone Jewels to the background.







Glue all completed squares to the 12" x 12" Designer Paper Cardboard and add to the frame!
