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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:


- Stamps: To Every Season
- Inks: Granny Apple Green
- Cardstock: (CS) Granny Apple Green Basic Black, Whisper White, Basic Gray
- Accessories:
- Tools: Punches Paper Trimmer, Big Shot, Subtle 3D Embossing Folder, Paper Snips, Tailored Tag, 1" & 1/2" Circle, Every Season Punch Pack, (Bat), White Stampin' Chalk Marker, Sponge
- Miscellaneous: Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Black Dimensionals, Black Sharpie, Mini Pizza Box

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using Granny Apple Green CS cut the following: (2) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2", (4) 17/16" x 3 1/2", (2) 1/2" x 1 1/8", Using Basic Gray cut (2) 1/2" x 1/2". Sponge around all pieces using Granny Apple Green Ink.



2. Punch out (2) 1" Circles using Whisper White, (1) 1" Circle using Granny Apple Green, (2) 1/2" Circles using Basic Black. Sponge around the White and Green Circles with Granny Apple Green Ink.



3. Cut a piece of Basic Black CS at 11" x 1 1/4". Using your Paper Snips cut zig zags in the long side to make it look like hair. After your done run it through the Big Shot using the Subtle 3D Embossing Folder.



4. Attach the Green pieces on the box using the Multipurpose Glue. Place eyes and nose on box where they will be going and using the Black Sharpie draw a couple of scars and the mouth. Glue down the whites of the eyes. Using the White Chalk Marker add a bit of highly to the black circles and adhere them to the box with a Bigger Black Dimensional. Attach eyebrows with Dimensionals. Add the nose using 2 Dimensionals stacked on top of each other.



5. Cut (2) more Granny Apple Green 1/2" x 1 1/8" strips. Using Paper Snips cut the end off to look like a triangle. These will be the ears. Sponge the ends with Granny Apple Green Ink.



6. Attach the ears to the sides of the box with Multipurpose Glue and the bolts with Black Mini Glue Dots.



7. Wrap the Hair piece around the box overlapping the ends and glue, Make sure the piece can slide of the box easily.



8. Stamp the "Happy Halloween" image onto a scrap of Granny Apple Green and punch out using the Tailored Tag Punch. Punch out a few bats with the Bat Punch and Basic Black CS. Glue the tag and bats to the inside of the box.
