
Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Snowman Season (150458)
- Cardstock: Bermuda Bay (1311997), Coastal Cabana (131297)
- Designer Paper: Let It Snow Specialty (150393)
- Accessories: Bermuda Bay Mini Striped Ribbon (146939), Snowflake Sequins (150443)
- Tools: Snow Globe Shaker Dome (150442), Snow Globes Scenes Dies (150655), Simply Scored (122334), Tear & Tape (138995), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)
- Miscellaneous: Velcro Dots

INSTRUCTIONS:


Step 1:

Cut a piece of Bermuda Bay Cardstock to measure 11" x 4". Score at 4", 5", 6", & 10". Score on all scored lines:




Step 2:

Cut (3) pieces of Coastal Cabana Cardstock to measure 3-3/4" x 3-3/4" and (4) pieces to measure 3-3/4" x $\frac{3}{4}$ ":



Step 3:

Glue the Coastal Cabana Cardstock layers to the Bermuda Bay Cardstock base on the inside on all panels and on the outside as shown in photo 2:




Step 4:

Cut the following using the designer paper-(4) strips to measure 3-1/2 x $\frac{1}{2}$, and (3) pieces to measure 3-1/2 x 3-1/2. Cut holes in the center of two pieces using the die that measures 2-5/8 from the Layering Circles Dies:



Step 5:

Add Tear & Tape to three sides of each square with a hole. Glue to the inside of the card base. Make sure the end without the Tear & Tape is at the top to slide photos in and out. Glue the small strips of designer paper to each smaller section:



Step 6:

- Using the sheet of designer paper with the snowmen, cut (1) snowman.
- Using the sheet of designer paper with the trees, cut one of each tree.
- Using one of the circles cut from the designer paper in Step 4, use the die to cut the globe shape.
- Cut a circle that measures 3" from the Layering Circles Dies using Bermuda Bay Cardstock. Cut the center of the circle out using the globe shape.
- Peel the backing on the front of the Snow Globe Shaker Dome and press the Bermuda Bay Cardstock to the front:






Step 7:

- Glue the designer paper to the front of the album.
- Glue the globe-shaped designer paper to the front about ¼" from the bottom of the designer paper layer.
- Glue the snowman and one tree to the designer paper globe using Stampin' Dimensionals. Add the 2nd tree flat over the snowman.
- Add Snowflake Sequins to the center over the snowman.
- Peel the backing from the back of the Snow Globe Shaker Dome and press in place of the snowman layer.
- Create a bow with the ribbon and press in place with Mini Glue Dots:



Step 8:

- Add Tear & Tape to the flap on the inside that folds over the top of the album, and press about 16" of ribbon in place, centering the ribbon. Add a Velcro Dot over the ribbon.
- Wrap the ribbon around to the front after the designer paper is glued in place and tie into a bow:



Step 9:

- Hand-cut two of the snowmen from the designer paper and glue in each corner of the designer paper frames on the inside.
- Add a photo inside each frame and the album sits up for displaying:
