



## Thanksgiving Table Place Setting

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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- *Stamps:* Birds of a Feather
- *Inks:* Pumpkin Pie, Crumb Cake, Black Memento
- *Blends:* Pumpkin Pie, Bermuda Bay, Smoky Slate, So Saffron, Crumb Cake
- *Cardstock:* 12"x12" Silver Foil, Crumb Cake, Pumpkin Pie, 8½"x11" Whisper White, Cajun Craze
- *Accessories:* Snowfall Accents Puff Paint, Come to Gather Ribbon Combo Pack

- Tools: 1" Circle Punch, 2¼" Circle Punch, 2" Circle Punch, Paper Trimmer, Heating Tool
- Miscellaneous: Sponges, Stampin' Dimensionals, Multipurpose Glue

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

For the 'PIE'

1. Cut a 6" diameter circle from the Silver Foil (this will use up almost the whole sheet).
2. Cut a 5" diameter circle from the Pumpkin Pie. Sponge randomly on the circle itself to break up the solid colour using the Pumpkin Pie ink and sponge..
3. Punch approximately 36 1" circles from Crumb Cake Cardstock and sponge around the edges using the Crumb Cake ink and sponge.
4. Cut a V piece from the Pumpkin Circle. Sponge around the edges.
5. Cut 2 strips of Crumb Cake at ¾" x 6". Sponge the edges.
6. Start to drop the Snowfall Accents Puff Paint around the outer edges of the Pumpkin Pie circle and the V slice – you need to do this in small amounts then use the heat tool to puff up the liquid. Build up until you have about 1" of puffed paint around the edge.
7. Glue one of the Crumb Cake strips to the top edge of the cut out V in the Pumpkin Pie circle and one to the bottom edge of the 'slice' leaving about 1/4" to be seen to look like the crumb base of the pie. You can angle this to make it look a little more realistic. Don't overlap the outer edge of these.
8. Put glue on the back of the Pumpkin Pie circle leaving about 1½" around the edge with no glue. Stick this to the silver foil centering them together.
9. Put a little glue on one of the 1" Crumb Cake circle punched shapes, tuck it about half way under the Pumpkin Pie Circle and press down - repeat for all around the outside of the Pumpkin Pie circle overlapping the Crumb Cake circles just a little – leaving no gaps between them. Add some circles around the outer edge of the 'slice'.
10. Glue the 'slice' to the 'Pie Dish' in the V area.

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

### For the Napkin Ring

1. Stamp the turkey from the Birds of a Feather Stamp set using Memento on Whisper White card stock.
2. Using Blends colour in the turkey and then cut out.
3. Punch a 2¼" circle from Cajun Craze Cardstock and a 2" circle from Whisper White Cardstock. Centre on top of one another and glue together. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the cut out turkey and stick to the layered circles.
4. Cut a 1½" x 4" strip of Crumb Cake cardstock. Wrap around the napkin, overlap the edges by enough to glue closed into a ring. (Depending on your napkin you may need a longer strip of Crumb Cake.
5. Cut a 5" strip of the Crumb Cake ribbon from the Come to Gather Ribbon Combo pack and wrap it around the napkin on top of the Crumb Cake cardstock. (Again – you may need a longer piece of ribbon depending on the size of your napkin) Cut an 8" piece of the Cajun Craze thread, fold in half and tie it in a knot around the Crumb Cake ribbon tails. Trim the Crumb Cake ribbon at an angle.
6. Glue the circles with the turkey on to the Crumb Cake ring just below the ribbon/thread knot.
