

# **Painted Poppies Pop-Up Box Card**

## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Painted Poppies (151599)
- Inks: Poppy Parade (147050), Blackberry Bliss (147092), Mossy Meadow (147111)
- Cardstock: Whisper White (100730), Poppy Parade (119793)
- Designer Paper: Peaceful Poppies (151324)
- Accessories: Peaceful Poppies Sequins (151325), Linen Thread (104199)
- Tools: Poppy Moments Dies (151594), Label Me Fancy Punch (151297), Simply Scored (122334), Bone Folder (102300), Liquid Glue (110755), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**





- Step 1: Cut a piece of Peaceful Poppies Designer Paper to measure 11" x 8-1/2".
- Place the 8-1/2" end vertically on your score board and score at 2-1/8" on each end.
- Turn the designer paper to the 11" side vertically and score at 1-1/4" and 3-3/8" on both ends.





• Step 2: Fold on the two score lines on the 8-1/2" sides towards the center to create the two flaps.





• Step 3: On the 11" side, fold on the two score lines on each end to the center to resemble the photos. You are folding in the opposite direction on each flap.





• Step 4: Flip the folded designer paper from Step 3 over to the reverse side. Grab each corner of the top layer and fold into two corners that meet. Repeat for both sides.







• Step 5: Open all of the flaps and starting with one corner first, grab the fold you see in photo 2 facing you and fold on the score line behind to lay flat against the side of the box. Repeat for the 2<sup>nd</sup> corner on the same side so both corners look like photo 3 once folded over. Repeat for side 2 of the box.





Once all folds have been completed, this is what your project should look like. You should be able to fold towards the center so project is flat.



#### Decorate the inside of the box:

- Step 1: Cut a piece of Whisper White Cardstock to measure 4" x 4".
- Step 2: Stamp the sentiment at the top right using Poppy Parade Ink.
- Step 3: Stamp the flower image and a few leaves using Blackberry Bliss Ink. Stamp the bold flower image using Poppy Parade Ink. Add inked splotches to the flower and leaves with the stamp image and Mossy Meadow Ink.
- Glue to the inside of the box.







### Creating the belly band:

- Step 1: Cut a piece of designer paper to measure 12" x 2".
- Step 2: Cut a  $2^{nd}$  piece of designer paper to measure  $12" \times 1-1/2"$ .
- Step 3: Layer and glue them together.
- Step 4: Wrap the belly band around the card loosely so it can slide on and off.
- Step 5: Glue the ends together overlapped and trim if needed.







#### Decorating the Belly Band:

- Step 1: Stamp the flower and leaf images like you did for the inside of the box on a piece of Whisper White Cardstock and cut out with the dies.
- Step 2: Cut out (1) of the swirly circle using the die and Poppy Parade Cardstock.
- Step 3: Glue the flower and leaves to the swirly using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Step 4: Add liquid glue to the center of the flower and add (3) gold Peaceful Poppies Sequins. I pushed them up against each other for height.
- Tag: Cut (1) tag using the Label Me Fancy Punch and Whisper White Cardstock. Punch a hole at the top using the punch also. Stamp the sentiment using Poppy Parade Ink. Tie to the belly band by wrapping the twine around the flower and tying into a bow.
