Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamp: Love What You Do (148042)

Cardstocks: Cherry Cobbler (119685), Early Espresso (119686), Gold Foil (132622), Whisper white (100730)

DSP: Christmastime is Here Specialty (152154)

Dies: Roses Dies (152144)

Embossing: Tufted 3D (151785)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114)

Ribbon & Twine: Gold 1/4" Shimmer Ribbon (152156)

Misc: Gold Glitter Enamel Dots (152155)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Cherry Cobbler - 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Layer: Gold Foil - 4" x 5 1/4"

Textured layer: Early Espresso - 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Cut the Gold Foil layer
2. Texture the Early Espresso layer using the Tufted 3D Embossing Folder and adhere to the Gold layer
3. Use the trellis style die from Roses Dies to die cut the shape out of a scrap of Gold Foil and use a Glue Pen to apply glue to the back of it and adhere onto the brown layer
4. Cut a strip of green patterned paper and adhere across the trellis on the brown layer
5. Cut a piece of Gold Shimmer Ribbon and wrap around the green paper and adhere with tape on the back
6. Adhere these layers to the Cherry Cobbler card base
7. Take a sheet of paper from Christmastime is Here Specialty DSP and the coordinating die from Roses Dies and cut out one of the floral panels – use Dimensionals to adhere to your card
8. Stamp your sentiment using Early Espresso Ink onto a scrap of paper – I used a Thank You stamp from the stamp set Love What You Do - and die cut out using another die from Roses Dies – adhere on top of the floral panel using Dimensionals
9. Add a few Gold Glitter Enamel dots for a sparkly finishing touch and your beautiful card is ready for giving!

You can theme this card for any occasion simply by changing what sentiment stamp you use – here are other cards I made using different sentiment stamps:
