## Supplies:

Stamp: The Gang's All Meer (152294) - FREE during SAB! Itty Bitty Birthdays (148618)
Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Basic Black (121045), Basic Gray (121044), Blueberry Bushel (146968), Rich Razzleberry (115316)
Glitter Paper: Silver (146960)
Dies: Layering Squares Dies (151772)
Punch: Banner Triple (138292)
Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Blueberry Bushel (147138), Rich Razzleberry (147091)
Blends: Crumb Cake Light (144582), Crumb Cake Dark (144581), Gray Granite Light (149535)
Twine: Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine (124262)
Tools: Paper Snips (103579), Paper Trimmer (152392), Die Cutting Machine
Misc: Clear Faceted Gems (144142), Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332), Grid Paper (130148)

## **Cutting Measurements:**

Card base: Basic Black - 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 ½ Strips: Blueberry Bushel & Rich Razzleberry – 1/2" x 4 1/4" Gray Layer: Basic Gray 3 3/4" x 5" Silver Layer 2: Silver Glimmer 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"

## Instructions:

- Cut colorful strips and adhere in place use a piece of grid paper as a guide for perfect alignment
- Cut Basic Gray layer and adhere on top of the strips
- Stamp the Meerkats on a piece of white cardstock and color using Blends Markers
- Stamp and cut out the party hats and glue in place
- Cut the Silver Glimmer layer and use a square die to create the window use Dimensionals to adhere in place over the Meerkat scene
- Adhere in place onto gray layer
- Cut a piece of black cardstock to be 1" wide and use the Banner Triple punch to shape one end cut the other to side and adhere to the silver layer
- Tie around a piece of Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine and finish with a bow on front
- Stamp Happy birthday onto a scrap of white cardstock, trim to size and add to the black tag using Dimensionals each side of the twine
- Add a sparkly Faceted Gem for a finishing touch and your cute card is ready for giving  $\, \odot \,$
