


Valentine's Chocolate Square Holder



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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamp: Meant to Be (148626) Die: Stitched Be Mine Dies (148527) Cardstocks: Real Red (100482), Whisper White (100730) DSP: From My Heart Specialty (151189) Ink: Early Espresso (147114) Ribbon: Real Red 3/8" Double Stitched Satin (151155) Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips (103579), Simply Scored (122334), Bone Folder (102300), Handheld 1/4" Circle Punch, Die Cutting Machine Adhesives: Tear & Tape (138995), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332) Misc: Ghirardelli Chocolate Squares



Gently pull up the other side so that both top edges align – use the cuts you just made as a guide to cut the back section too:




And this is what you will have...




To make the hole for the ribbon, measure the centerpoint between the corners and make a pencil mark

Use a handheld punch in the size of your choice to make your hole:







Decorate, tie twine or ribbon through the holes, finish with a bow and your gift is ready for giving!
