



Valentine's Chocolate Square Holder

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamp: Meant to Be (148626)

Die: Stitched Be Mine Dies (148527)

Cardstocks: Real Red (100482), Whisper White (100730)

DSP: From My Heart Specialty (151189)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114)

Ribbon: Real Red 3/8" Double Stitched Satin (151155)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips (103579), Simply Scored (122334), Bone Folder (102300), Handheld 1/4" Circle Punch, Die Cutting Machine

Adhesives: Tear & Tape (138995), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Misc: Ghirardelli Chocolate Squares

Cut a piece of cardstock in the color of your choice to measure 8" x 2" – score at 3 1/2" and 4 1/2" and fold along those score lines



To shape the top corners, use a piece of grid paper as a guide – line up your cardstock strip on the grid:



And make pencil marks half an inch along and down on both sides and use sharp Paper Snips to cut the corners away using those pencil marks as your guide:



Gently pull up the other side so that both top edges align – use the cuts you just made as a guide to cut the back section too:



And this is what you will have...



To make the hole for the ribbon, measure the centerpoint between the corners and make a pencil mark

Use a handheld punch in the size of your choice to make your hole:



To make the side pieces, cut two pieces of cardstock to measure 2" x 1"



Score in at 1/2" from both edges – repeat for the other piece:



Fold along the score lines to create tabs:



Apply strong adhesive tape to the outside tabs:



And adhere to the inside of the box – repeat for the other side:



Fill with 3 Ghirardelli Chocolate Squares or some Hershey Nuggets:



Decorate, tie twine or ribbon through the holes, finish with a bow and your gift is ready for giving!
