

Under My Umbrella Raindrops Card



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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Under My Umbrella (151518)

Bundle: Under My Umbrella Bundle (153786)

Punches: Umbrella Builder (151293), Small Bloom (152316)

DSP: Pleased as Punch (153558)

Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Basic Black (121045), Crumb Cake (120953)

Die Cutting: Heirloom Frames Dies (152325), Stitched Rectangle Dies (148551)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Ribbon: Whisper White Crinkled Seam Binding (151326)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

White card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Black layer: 4" x 5 1/4"

White layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Cut the white layer and wrap around a piece of white ribbon and secure it to the back
2. Cut the black layer and adhere the white one on top of it – then adhere to the card base
3. Use a die from Heirloom Frames Dies to cut a window out of Crumb Cake cardstock
4. Cut a piece of rain patterned paper from Pleased as Punch DSP to fit the window hole – adhere to the back of your Crumb Cake Frame – then adhere to the card front
5. Use the Umbrella Builder Punch to punch out the handle from a scrap of black cardstock and punch out the patterned umbrella from the coordinating piece of paper in Pleased as Punch DSP
6. Adhere the handle in place using glue and the umbrella piece using Dimensionals to make it pop out
7. Stamp the sentiment and cut it out – I used a die from Stitched Rectangle Dies to cut mine – and adhere in place
8. Use the Small Bloom Punch to cut out a flower from the coordinating piece of paper in Pleased as Punch DSP and attach using a Dimensional
9. Your pretty card is finished and ready for giving 😊
