Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: You Always Deliver

• Inks: Early Espresso

• Cardstock: Whisper White, Flirty Flamingo

• Designer Paper: Bird Ballad DSP

• Accessories: 5/8" Polka Dot Tulle Ribbon, Acetate Card Boxes, Whisper White Solid Baker's Twine, 3 x 6" Gusseted Cellophane Bags

• Tools: Classic Label Punch, Dog Builder Punch

Miscellaneous: Items/treats of your choice for inside the box.
I used:

Fun Size Peanut M&Ms

Lemonade Stick Pack

Lemon Jelly Beans

Yellow Hard Candy Disks

\$5 Dunkin Donuts Gift Card

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Assemble the card box and set aside.

2. Cut a 2 x 12 inch strip of the Bird Ballad Designer Series Paper. (I used the yellow design with the tiny white bird feet). Score the paper at the following

measurements:

• 3-3/8 inches

• 4 inches

• 8-1/2 inches

• 9-1/8 inches



3. Wrap the band around the box matching your score lines with the edges of the box. Secure the ends (on the back side of the box) with your adhesive of choice.

- 4. Cut a length of the polka dot tulle ribbon long enough to wrap around from the back to the front of the box and tie a bow.
- 5. Stamp the sentiment from the You Always Deliver stamp set onto a 3/8 inch strip of Whisper White Cardstock. (It's actually better to cut the strip just a hair under this width.)
- 6. Take your strip and feed through the BACK of the Classic Label punch. Line up where you want the end to be and punch.



7. Flip the strip to the other end and repeat step 6.



8. Once your sentiment piece is trimmed on both ends, apply to the front of the box with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.



- 9. Cut a small heart from Flirty Flamingo cardstock using the Dog Builder Punch and adhere to the sentiment piece with a Mini Glue Dot.
- 10. Fill the box with your treats and close. It is now ready to brighten someone's day!
