Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Ornate Thanks (149471), Ornate Style (152572)

Cardstocks: Crushed Curry (131199), Whisper White (100730), Soft Suede (115318), Crumb Cake (120953), Vellum (101856)

DSP: Ornate Garden Specialty (152488), Subtles 6x6 (149615)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Soft Suede (147115)

Blends Markers: Mango Melody Dark (147944), Old Olive Light (144574), Soft Suede Light (146874)

Dies: Stitched Shapes Dies (152323), Detailed Bee Dies (151526)

Embossing: Subtle 3D Folder (151775)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips (103579), Simply Scored (122334), Bone Folder (102300)

Misc: Gilded Gems (152478), Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (141897), Whisper White Crinkled Seam Binding (151326), PocketBac Hand Sanitizer from Bath & Body Works

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332), Tear & Tape (138995)

Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 5 3/4" x 3 3/4" – place into your score tool with the short edge along the top and score down at 1" and again at 4 3/4"



Turn around so that the longest edge is along the top of your score tool and score down at 2" and 3"



To create small flaps, take scissors and cut down to the intersecting lines for those two small panels each side



Fold along all score lines



Place strong adhesive tape on the outer sides of those two small flaps



And adhere to the back section



Apply strong adhesive tape to the inside front side flaps



And adhere to the side panels



Take your scissors and cut a diagonal line from corner to corner



And repeat for the other side



Pop in your Pocket Bac and it's time to decorate!
