



## HALLOWEEN CURVY TREAT HOLDER

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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Ghoulish Goodies (153362), Have a Hoot (153389), Banner Year (153464)

Cardstocks: Basic Black (121045), Whisper White (100730), Black Glitter Paper (153518)

DSP: Magic in This Night (153517), Heartwarming Hugs (153492)

Die Cutting: Hippo & Friends Dies (153585), Special Day Dies (153587)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Blends Markers: Gray Granite Combo (149537), Smoky Slate Combo (145058), Pumpkin Pie Combo (154897), Mossy Meadow Combo (148547), Mango Melody Combo (154888)

Ribbon: Black 3/8" Glittered Organdy (147897)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips (103579), Simply Scored (122334), Bone Folder (102300), Stampin Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)

Misc: Holiday Rhinestone Jewels (150457), Elegant Faceted Gems (152464), Four Hershey Nuggets

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Black Dimensionals (150893), Tear & Tape (138995), Snail (104332)

Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 5" x 5 ½" and place into your scoring tool with the longest edge along the top – score down at 2" and 3 ½"



Turn around so that the shorter edge is along the top and score down at 2" and 3"



Use your scissors to cut 4 cuts from the outer edges to the center panel on each side to create two tabs



And now to make the tabs – you are going to have 2 tabs at the top and 2 different sized tabs at the bottom. Place into your paper trimmer with the longest edge along the top – you are going to cut off 1" – to do this make sure you fold your center tab in on itself to avoid cutting it ☺



The bottom tab is going to be cut even more – fold in the tab you just created and slide your cardstock over a further 1/4" and cut



You will have a larger tab at the top and a smaller one at the bottom



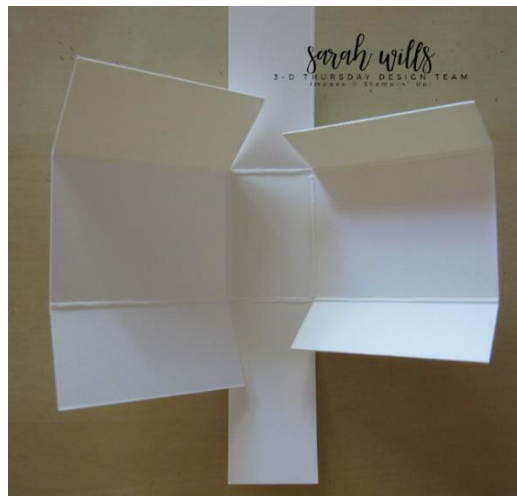
Repeat what you just did on the other side



And this is the shape you should have



Fold along all score lines



Turn over and apply strong adhesive tape to two of the flaps



Stand it up and adhere in place to the opposing tab each side



Apply tape to the two 'cover' tabs, fold up and adhere in place – these give strength to you box 😊



Fold up and secure in place – and now your box is ready for filling – it holds 4 Hershey Nuggets





If you would like to decorate your Nuggets, cut strips of paper 1" x 3" and run a line of adhesive tape on the back – then gently pop it on top of your Nugget and wrap around, securing on the back.

You can leave your box as is or wrap it with patterned paper like I did – to do this, cut a piece of patterned paper 5 1/2" x 2" – stand your box up and gently wrap the paper around it and make creases on all four corners – take off and use a bone folder to make your folds crisp – apply adhesive to the back and adhere in place.



To make the curvy front and back panels for this box – take a die from Hippo & Friends Dies and cut two pieces in the color of cardstock of your choice.

Use a paper trimmer to cut the bottom off of both pieces and there you have a curvy tombstone shaped piece ☺ I cut the front panel out of Black Glitter Paper and the back out of Black cardstock – I punched a hole in the top of each and threaded a piece of ribbon through to hold them together.



This is how I decorated – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:
