CARD 1 – CLEAN & SIMPLE HARVEST HELLOS THANKFUL CARD

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Harvest Hellos (150581) Punch: Apple Builder (150663)

BUNDLE: Harvest Hellos Bundle (153037) - includes both the Harvest Hellos Stamp Set & Apple

Builder Punch at 10% off!

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Very Vanilla (101650), Pumpkin Pie (105117), Granny

Apple Green (146990)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114), Granny Apple Green (147095)

Adhesives: Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Optional – Dimensionals (104430)

Tools: Paper Trimmer

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Early Espresso - 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Layer: Very Vanilla – 5" x 3 3/4"

Instructions:

- 1. Layer the Very Vanilla layer onto the card base and stamp 'Give Thanks' in Early Espresso Ink
- 2. Stamp the pumpkin using Early Espresso Ink onto a piece of Pumpkin Pie cardstock and cut out using the Apple Builder Punch
- 3. Stamp the leaf using the same ink onto a scrap of Granny Apple Green cardstock cut out using the Apple Builder Punch stamp & punch out stem using Early Espresso
- 4. Use Mini Glue Dots to attach the leaf & stem to the back of the pumpkin
- 5. Position where you want your pumpkin to be on the card front and line up your twirly stamp move your pumpkin out of the way and using Granny Apple Green Ink stamp the vine onto the vanilla layer
- 6. Adhere your pumpkin in place using Dimensionals to give it a lift
- 7. Add a piece of Very Vanilla cardstock onto the inside to write on and voila − your beautiful card is ready for giving ⊕



CARD 2 – STEPPED UP HARVEST HELLOS THANKFUL CARD

Die Cutting: Gathered Leaves Dies (150662), Ornate Frames Dies (150664)

Embossing: Pinewood Planks (152320)

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Very Vanilla (101650), Crumb Cake (120953), Pumpkin Pie

(105117), Cajun Craze (119684), Bermuda Bay (131197), Sahara Sand (121043)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114) Twine: Linen Thread (104199)

Adhesives: Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Dimensionals (104430)

Tools: Paper Trimmer, Die Cutting Machine

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Early Espresso - 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Layer: Very Vanilla – 5" x 3 3/4"

Embossed Layer: Crumb Cake – 4 7/8" x 3 5/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Layer the Very Vanilla layer onto the card base
- 2. Emboss the Crumb Cake layer using the Pinewood Planks embossing folder and adhere in place
- 3. Using a die from Gathered Leaves Dies cut out three leaves from Sahara Sand, Bermuda Bay and Cajun Craze cardstock scraps position and adhere in place
- 4. Stamp the pumpkin using Early Espresso Ink onto a piece of Pumpkin Pie cardstock and cut out using the Apple Builder Punch
- 5. Stamp the stem using Early Espresso Ink onto Early Espresso cardstock and use the Apple Builder Punch to cut it out use a glue dot to adhere to the back of the pumpkin
- 6. Attach your pumpkin to the card front using Dimensionals
- 7. Stamp 'Give Thanks' onto a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock and use a die from Ornate Frames Dies to cut it out use a piece of Linen Thread to tie through the hole and finish with a bow add to your pumpkin using Dimensionals
- 8. Add a piece of Very Vanilla cardstock onto the inside to write on and voila your pretty card is ready for giving ©

Embossing: Pinewood Planks (152320)

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Very Vanilla (101650), Crumb Cake (120953), Pumpkin Pie

(105117), Cajun Craze (119684), Bermuda Bay (131197), Sahara Sand (121043), Vellum

(101856)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114)
Twine: Linen Thread (104199)

Adhesives: Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Dimensionals (104430)

Tools: Paper Trimmer, Die Cutting Machine

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Early Espresso - 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Layer: Very Vanilla – 5" x 3 3/4"

Embossed Layer: Crumb Cake – 4 7/8" x 3 5/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Layer the Very Vanilla layer onto the card base
- 2. Emboss the Crumb Cake layer using the Pinewood Planks embossing folder and adhere in place
- 3. Using dies from Gathered Leaves Dies cut out a variety of leaves from Vellum, Sahara Sand, Bermuda Bay and Cajun Craze cardstock scraps position in layers & stack them up adhere in place as you go
- 4. Stamp the pumpkin using Early Espresso Ink onto a piece of Pumpkin Pie cardstock and cut out using the Apple Builder Punch
- 5. Stamp the stem using Early Espresso Ink onto Early Espresso cardstock and use the Apple Builder Punch to cut it out use a glue dot to adhere to the back of the pumpkin
- 6. Attach your pumpkin on top of the pile of leaves using Dimensionals
- 7. Stamp 'Give Thanks' onto a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock and use a die from Ornate Frames Dies to cut it out use a piece of Linen Thread to tie through the hole and finish with a bow add to your pumpkin using Dimensionals
- 8. Add the sparkly touch of a little Pumpkin Pie Rhinestone Jewel to your pumpkin
- 9. Add a piece of Very Vanilla cardstock onto the inside to write on and voila your absolutely fabulous WOW card is ready for giving ©
