Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamp: Dove of Hope (153406)

Dies: Detailed Dove (153526)

BUNDLE: Dove of Hope Bundle (155158) – includes Dove of Hope Stamp Set + Detailed Dove Dies

Embossing Folder: Scripty (149634)

Cardstocks: Pretty Peacock (150880), Shimmery White (101910), Old Olive (100702), Brass (153057) OR Gold (132622) Foil Sheets

Ink: Pretty Peacock (150083)

Embellies: Red Rhinestone Jewels (146924), Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (141897)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Stampin Seal (149699), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Cutting Measurements:

Pretty Peacock Card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Gold Layer: 4" x 5 1/4"

Pretty Peacock Embossed layer: 3 3/4" x 5"

Instructions:

- Cut and score your card base
- Adhere the Gold Foil layer in place
- Use the Scripty Embossing Folder to emboss your Pretty Peacock layer
- Use Pretty Peacock Ink and a branch stamp from Dove of Hope to stamp the branches in opposing corners
- Add Red Rhinestone Jewels and adhere layer to the card
- Use dies from Detailed Dove Dies to cut your Dove pieces – use the Fine Tip Glue Pen to adhere the intricate cut wing to its base and then use Dimensionals to adhere all pieces to the card
- Die cut the Old Olive branch and use your Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush to add some shimmer and adhere to the card just under the Dove's beak
- If desired, you can also use the Wink of Stella brush to add shimmer to the embossed layer
- And voila – your card is ready for giving!
