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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Kits: Sweet Little Valentines Cards & More (154287), Little Love Boxes Add-On (156842)

Stamps: Meant To Be (148626), Punch Party - SAB Host (155300), Handmade For You (154494)

Cardstocks: Basic White (159276), Melon Mambo (115320), Pool Party (122924)

Specialty Sheets: Gold Foil (132622), Love You Always Foil (154286)

Dies: Be Mine Stitched (151814), Playful Alphabet (152706), Layering Circles (151770), Stitched Shapes (152323)

Ink: Melon Mambo (147051)

Ribbons: Pool Party Sheer 3/8" (152462), Blushing Bride 3/8" Metallic (154283), Gold 1/4" Shimmer (152156)

Embellishments: Gilded Gems (152478), Resin Hearts (154578)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (150673)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Stampin' Seal (152813)

Other supplies used: Book Ring, Handheld 1/8" Circle Punch or Cropadile

To create the pages of your mini album you are going to use 2 cards and 4 printed layers from the Sweet Little Valentines Cards & More kit – take out one of each:



Cut the cards in half:



Stack them together along with the 4 printed layers and punch a hole in the top left corner – you can do this as one stack if you use a strong punching tool such as a Cropadile but if you are using a handheld circle punch you will need to do them one at a time – just be sure to get the hole in the same place on each card.

For the 4 pieces from the cards that I cut in half I decided to cover the reverse side with a piece of patterned paper – I found the perfect thing inside the envelopes that come with this card kit! I opened up 4 envelopes and cut the main panel to size – some have gold dots and some gold stripes:



This makes a nice background to add little photos to:



For the 4 printed layers I chose the side I wanted to use and covered the reverse side with a piece of cardstock to add journaling – but if you prefer you can leave the pattern showing– entirely up to you!



And then you decorate them as you would like - all supplies I used are listed in the Supply List at the top of this tutorial – and once done, pop the pages onto a book ring and add ribbons!



I left my back page blank so that I can write a message:



And the back cover has a simple handmade stamp on it:
