

Art Gallery Fluttering Wall Hanging

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Art Gallery Bundle (156227), Floating & Fluttering Bundle (156239), A Touch Of Ink (155233), Happy Thoughts (154507)
- Inks: Early Espresso (147114), Calypso Coral (147101), Daffodil Delight (147094), Granny Apple Green (147095), VersaMark (102283)

- Cardstock: Purple Posy (150881)
- Designer Paper: In Good Taste (152494)
- Accessories: Linen Thread (104199)
- Tools: Foam Adhesive Sheets (152815), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108), Heat & Stick Powder (156110), Heat Tool (129053), Gilded Leafing (154560), Stamping Sponge (141337), Liquid Glue (110755), Tear & Tape (138995), Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips Scissors (103579)
- Miscellaneous: Designer Paper Cardboard, ¼" Handheld Punch, Scrap Paper

INSTRUCTIONS:





Step 1:

You will need the following:

- (6) pieces of designer paper cardboard (or thin cardboard) 6" x 2".
- (3) pieces of In Good Taste Designer Paper 6" x 2". Use a light pattern so you can stamp on the paper.





Step 2:

Glue two layers of designer paper cardboard together. Repeat 3 times. Cut (3) Foam Adhesive Sheets to measure 1-7/8" wide. Cut in half at 2-1/4". Glue two pieces to each end of the cardboard layers. You may use Stampin' Dimensionals if you do not have Foam Adhesive Sheets. Set aside.



Step 3:

Add a little bit of adhesive to the back of each In Good Taste Designer Paper strips and glue to a piece of scrap paper so that there is no spacing between each strip. Stamp the sentiment from the Happy Thoughts stamp set at the top right using Early Espresso Ink.

Stamp the flowers and stems from the Art Gallery stamp set using Calypso Coral Ink and Granny Apple Green Ink.



Step 4:

Stamp the detailed image over each flower using VersaMark Ink and sprinkle with Heat & Stick Powder. Melt the powder with the Heat Tool.



Step 5:

Once the Heat & Stick Powder has been melted, press the Gilded Leafing to each flower. Use a Stampin' Sponge to remove excess.





Step 6:

Stamp the smaller flower image from the Art Gallery stamp set three times using Daffodil Delight Ink on the In Good Taste Designer Paper (same pattern). Add Foam Adhesive Sheets under each flower and cut with the dies.

Stamp the small detailed stamp image over each flower using VersaMark Ink and sprinkle with Heat & Stick Powder. Melt the powder with the Heat Tool. Once the Heat & Stick Powder has been melted, press the Gilded Leafing to each flower. Use a Stampin' Sponge to remove excess.







Step 7:

Peel the backing on the Foam Adhesive Sheets and press the small flowers layered over the larger flowers. Remove the wood grain strips from the scrap paper and cut the small flowers with Paper Snips to separate your woodgrain strips.



Step 8:

Stamp the cluster of butterflies image from Floating & Fluttering on Purple Posy Cardstock using Early Espresso Ink. Cut each butterfly with the dies. Glue the butterflies in place as shown using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.



Step 9:

Cut a darker piece of In Good Taste Designer Paper to measure 6-3/4" x 6-1/2". The 6-1/2" side is horizontal. Glue all three completed strips to this layer of designer paper using Liquid Glue so you can position about $\frac{1}{4}$ " between each piece.





Step 10:

Use a ¼" handheld punch to add two holes at the top, one in each corner. Tie Linen Thread to each hole into a bow with enough for hanging. Add a little bit of Liquid Glue to the center of each bow. This will dry clear and avoid the bow coming apart when hanging.
