



## PAPER BLOOMS FLOWER VASE

### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

DSP: Paper Blooms (Sale-a-bration 2021 FREE DSP!)

Box: Clear Tiny Treat Boxes (141699)

Ribbon & Twine: Whisper White 1/4" Seam Binding (151326), Snail Mail Twine Combo Pack (154579)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips (103579)

Misc: Lollipop Sticks, 1/8" Handheld Circle Punch, Chocolate Eggs

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Tear & Tape (138995)

Take a Clear Tiny Treat Box and assemble – fill with eggs and close the lid making sure to press on all folds firmly to make your box nice and square.

Open the lid and using a handheld circle punch make a hole in it for a lollipop flower stem to go through – wherever you would like to position it 😊



Close the lid and using a permanent marker make a small mark in the center of the hole, on the flap beneath. Open your lid, open out the flap and use your hole punch to punch out that second hole



Of course if you would like, you can make more holes for more stems to go through but I decided on just one for my project.

Close the lid and your holes should line up nicely



Cut a piece of patterned paper to measure 1" x 8" – wrap around the bottom of your box and secure on the back with strong adhesive tape – the back of your box is going to be where the top flap tucks in.

If you prefer you can move the band up to the center of the box – leave as is or wrap around a piece of ribbon or twine and finish with a bow or knot in the front



Cut out your paper flowers and stems from patterned papers and use Glue Dots and Dimensionals to adhere them onto the lollipop sticks – slide a big flower on a stick into the back slit and push a smaller flower on a stick through the hole you made in the lid



I also used a Dimensional to adhere a large flower directly onto the front of my box.

This is how I decorated mine – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:
