

TO A WILD ROSE HELLO CARD



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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: To a Wild Rose (149452)

Die Cutting: Wild Rose Dies (149547)

Embossing: Pinewood Planks EF (152320)

Cardstocks: Very Vanilla (101650), Soft Suede (115318), Crumb Cake (120953), Vellum (101856), Champagne Foil (144748)

Inks: Crumb Cake (147116), Early Espresso (147114), Rococo Rose (150080), Old Olive (147090)

Misc: Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Stampin Seal (149699), Glue Dots (103683)

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Layer: 4" x 5 1/4"

Textured layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Cut the Soft Suede layer and adhere to the Vanilla base
2. Cut the Crumb Cake layer – apply ink to the Pinewood Planks Embossing Folder and put this layer into it – run it through your die cutting machine, remove and leave to dry – when dry, adhere onto the card
3. Use a die from Wild Rose Dies to cut the border piece from Vellum – cut in half and adhere in place
4. Stamp and die cut the flowers and leaves – adhere the leaves using adhesive tape and the flower using dimensionals
5. Stamp your sentiment just below the flower
6. Die cut extra leaves from Champagne Foil and adhere in place using glue dots
7. For the finishing touch add some epoxy droplets or jewels where desired
8. And now your pretty card is ready for giving!
