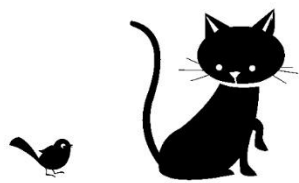

**You will receive all of the layers, embellishments and die cuts to create this card when you place an order this month in my Online Store! (excluding stamped images)**



### **Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:**

Stamp: Plentiful Plants (155693)

Die Cutting: Perfect Plants Dies (155562), Meadow Dies (155852)

Embossing: Macrame 3D Embossing Folder (155435)

Designer Series Papers: Bloom Where You're Planted (155696)

Cardstocks: Cinnamon Cider (153078), Basic White (159276)

Twine: Bakers Twine Essentials Pack (155475)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Tools: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Paper Trimmer (152392)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

### **Cutting Measurements:**

Card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Embossed Layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Patterned Paper Strip: 3 7/8" x 1/2"

### **Directions:**

1. Emboss the white layer using the Macrame Embossing Folder and adhere to the Cinnamon Cider base
2. Cut a strip of paper from Bloom Where You're Planted DSP and adhere in place
3. Use two dies from Perfect Plants Dies to cut out the coordinating plant pot and leaves images from the sheet of paper in Bloom Where You're Planted DSP
4. Adhere the die cuts on top of the strip
5. Wrap around a piece of white Bakers Twine and finish with a bow
6. Take a scrap of white cardstock and use the banner die from Meadow Dies to cut out the banner piece
7. Use the 'Thank You' stamp featured in the stamp set Plentiful Plants to stamp your sentiment onto it
8. Adhere to the card using Dimensionals
9. And there you have one pretty card ready for giving!
