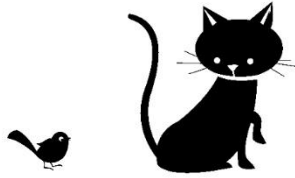

KANGAROO & COMPANY BABY CARD



Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Kangaroo & Company (154502)

Die Cutting: Stitched Rectangles Dies (151820), Tasteful Labels Dies (152886), Kangaroo Dies (154334)

BUNDLE: Kangaroo & Company Bundle (156269)

Cardstocks: Basic White (159276), Basic White Thick (159229)

Designer Series Paper: Snail Mail DSP (154577)

Twine: Bakers Twine Essentials Pack (155475)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Blends Markers: Crumb Cake (154882), Real Red (154899), Polished Pink (155520)

Misc: Resin Hearts Embellishments (154578)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (149699), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Tools: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Patterned Paper Layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Cut the patterned paper layer and adhere to the Thick Basic White card base
2. Use a large Stitched Rectangle Die to cut out a piece of Basic White cardstock and adhere to the layer
3. Wrap around a piece of white Bakers Twine and finish with a bow to the right side
4. Stamp 'hello baby' onto a scrap of white cardstock and use the banner die from Tasteful Labels Dies to cut it out – adhere under the white twine with Dimensionals to make it appear to be hanging
5. Stamp and die cut the Kangaroo & Baby Roo and color them using Crumb Cake Blends Markers – pop the baby Roo into the pouch and adhere to the card using Dimensionals
6. Stamp and die cut the Hearts and color them using Real Red and Polished Pink Blends Markers – adhere using Dimensionals
7. Dot around a few Resin Hearts Embellishments and your card is ready for giving!
