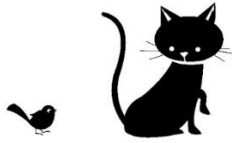

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Splendid Thoughts (159668), Lovely & Lasting (158646)

Die Cutting: Splendid Stems Dies (159676), Stylish Shapes Dies (159183)

BUNDLE: Splendid Thoughts Bundle (159677)

Embossing: Brick & Mortar 3D Embossing Folder (149643)

Cardstocks: Basic White Thick (159229), Sweet Sorbet (159268), Parakeet Party (159259), Fresh Freesia (155613), Basic White (159276),

Inks: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Misc: White 3/8" Glittered Organdy (156408), Pearl Basic Jewels (144219)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Cutting Measurements:

White Card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Sweet Sorbet Layer: 4" x 5 1/4"

Instructions:

1. Cut the Sweet Sorbet layer and use the Brick & Mortar Embossing Folder to texture it using your die cutting machine
2. Wrap around a piece of White Organdy Ribbon and tie a knot to the right side – adhere to the base
3. Using dies from Splendid Stems Dies, die cut four white stems and use glue to adhere them in place
4. Use Black Ink to stamp the leaves onto Parakeet Party cardstock and use the coordinating die to cut it out – adhere to the card
5. Stamp the flowers onto Fresh Freesia cardstock and again, use the coordinating die to cut it out – adhere on top of the green leaves so that it slightly overlaps the ribbon using Dimensionals
6. Stamp your sentiment, die cut it out and add to the card using Dimensionals
7. Dot around some Pearl Basic Jewels and your pretty card is ready for giving!
