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Sweetest Cherries Card



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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Sweetest Cherries (158711)

BUNDLE: Sweetest Cherries Bundle (158717)

Punch: Cherry Builder Punch (158716)

Cardstocks: Poppy Parade (119793), Basic Black (121045), Basic White (159276)

Inks: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Poppy Parade (147050), Old Olive (147090), Soft Suede (147115)

Misc: Matte Black Dots (154284), Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Cutting Measurements:

Red Card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Black Layer: 4" x 5 1/4" White Layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Adhere the black layer to the card base

- 2. Use Poppy Parade Ink to stamp 'sweet' to the bottom right of the Basic White layer and Black Ink to stamp 'thank you for...' at the top left adhere to the base
- 3. On a scrap of Basic White cardstock stamp three cherries using Poppy Parade Ink three stems using Soft Suede Ink and four leaves using Old Olive Ink
- 4. Use the Cherry Builder Punch to punch out all of those shapes then use your Fine Tip Glue Pen to adhere the stems to the cherries
- 5. Adhere the top two cherries to the card base adhere one leaf to the side of each stem, on opposing sides
- 6. Adhere the second leaves using Dimensionals and add a Rhinestone Jewel to each
- 7. Add the third cherry at the bottom just above the word 'sweet' using Dimensionals
- 8. Add a Black Matte Dot to the left side of the word 'sweet' and another Rhinestone Jewel to the right side of the third cherry and your sweet card is ready for giving!
