Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Waves of Inspiration (158833) Die Cutting: Waves Dies (158840)

BUNDLE: Waves of Inspiration Bundle (158841)

Cardstocks: Basic White (159276), Night of Navy (100867)

Inks: Early Espresso (147114), Night of Navy (147110), Bermuda Bay (147096), Pacific Point (147098)

Twine: Bakers Twine Essentials Pack (155475)

Misc: Sponge Daubers (133773); Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220) colored with Bermuda Bay Stampin'

Blends (154878) and Night of Navy Stampin' Blends (154891);

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Cutting Measurements:

Blue Card base: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" - scored at 4 1/4"

White Layer: 4" x 5 1/4"

Instructions:

1. Take the wave stamp and turn over – use a sponge dauber to dab on Night of Navy Ink – I applied that ink to the bottom corners and the center of the wave – make sure your ink pad is moist for ease of doing this

- 2. Take another sponge dauber and dab on Pacific Point Ink I applied that color to the bottom and part way up the side of the wave
- 3. Take another sponge dauber and dab on Bermuda Bay Ink I applied that to the top of the wave and randomly over the rest of it
- 4. Stamp firmly down onto the white layer and leave to dry
- 5. Use the wave die to cut a scrap of white cardstock and use Fine Tip Glue to adhere it onto your stamped wave
- 6. Die cut clouds and birds from scraps of white cardstock and adhere in place
- 7. Stamp the sentiment and die cut it out thread through white bakers twine and wrap twice around the white layer, securing with a bow in front use Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment tag to the card
- 8. Adhere this white layer to your blue card base
- 9. Finally add some Rhinestone Basic Jewels that you have colored using Stampin' Blends Markers NS your beautiful card is ready for giving!
