## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Sweet Gingerbread (159714)

Ink: Soft Suede (147115)

Cardstocks: Basic White 12x12 (159231), Balmy Blue (146982), Soft Suede (115318), Pear Pizzazz

(131201)

Specialty Papers: Snowflake Specialty Vellum (159832), Snowy White Velvet Sheets (156405)

Designer Series Paper: Storybook Gnomes (159615)

Die Cutting: Snowman Dies (159817), Stylish Shapes Dies (159183)

Ribbon: Iridescent Trim (159594) Misc: Festive Pearls (159963), M&Ms

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430), Tear & Tape (138995), Glue Pen (138309) Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300), Simply Scored (122334), Paper Snips (103579)

Take a piece of 12x12 sized cardstock – cut at 5" – keep the 12" x 5" piece and put the other to the side



Put into your scoring tool with a long side along the top edge – score at 5 3/4" and 6 1/4"



Turn so that the short edge is along the top edge and score at 1/2" and 4 1/2'



At the center of your piece of cardstock you will see intersecting lines – cut from the outer edge up to the 1/2" score line for each of the four lines to create two tabs



Fold along all score lines, using a bone folder to get them nice and crisp



Apply two lengths of strong adhesive tape to the two long tabs on the right



Carefully fold the two small tabs in and then the larger tabs to create your box



And now it is ready for decorating and filling! A small share sized packet of M&Ms fits in there nicely or you can pop in the treats of your choice...
