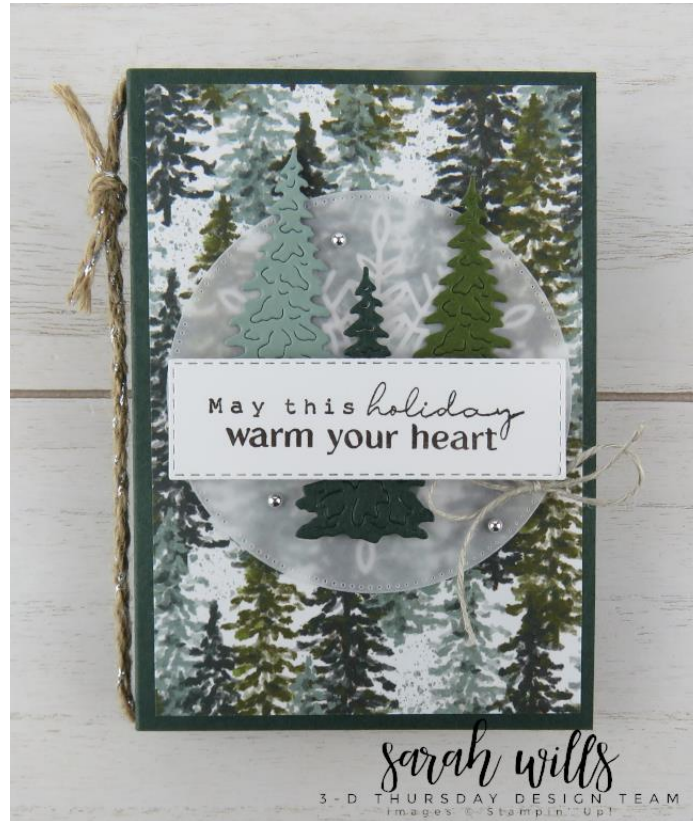




HOLIDAY HAND WARMER HOLDER

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamp: Cozy & Bright Card Kit (160338)

Die Cutting: Reindeer Dies (159727), Stylish Shapes Dies (159183), Stitched Rectangles Dies (151820)

Designer Series Paper: Boughs of Holly DSP (159600)

Cardstocks: Evening Evergreen (155574), Soft Succulent (155776), Mossy Meadow (133676), Basic White (159276), Vellum (101856)

Inks: Early Espresso (147114)

Ribbon & Twine: Linen Thread (104199), Silver Threaded Twine (159662)

Embellishments: Festive Pearls (159963), Wonderful Snowflakes (156340)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300), Simply Scored (122334)

Other Supplies: Hot Hands Hand Warmer

Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 7 1/2" x 5"



Place into your scoring tool with a long edge at the top and score at 3 1/2" and 4"



Cut two pieces of patterned papers for the front and back panels of the cover to measure 3 1/4" x 4 3/4"– you can use the same paper for both or different - I chose different



And adhere in place



Cut two more pieces of the same size for the inside and adhere in place



And now you are ready to decorate!

Once you have decorated the front panel, pop your hand warmer inside and use a length of ribbon or twine to tie around it and the spine of the cover, securing with a knot on the outside – this should hold it in place but if you want a snugger fit, use a couple of glue dots



This is how I decorated – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:
