



STICKY NOTES HOLDER WITH CALENDAR & PEN

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Basic White 12x12 (159231)

Designer Series Paper: Flowers & More Host DSP 12x12 (160802), Dandy Designs Sale-a-bration DSP (160836)

Tools: Simply Scored (122334), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (138995)

Misc: Calendar Pad, White Sticky Notes Pad, Mini Pen

Cut a piece of 12x12 cardstock to measure 12" x 5 1/2" and place into your scoring tool with a short edge along the top – score at 1/2", 1", 5" and 4 1/2"



Turn so that a long edge is at the top and score at 2", 2 1/2", 6", 9 1/2", 10 1/2" and 11 1/2"



Turn so that the panel with the small squares is near the bottom – use your paper trimmer to cut down the long edges along the second score line in, down to the small square sections – cut along to remove that strip and repeat for the other side



Cut away the outer small square each side – then cut on to the score line and fold to create the tabs



Fold along all score lines and apply strong adhesive tape to the outer strips



Fold in and adhere to the back panel – this is where your sticky notes pad will fit



Fold along the remaining score lines and use a bone folder to make them nice and crisp



Apply strong adhesive tape to the end tab and tuck under



Adhere to the reverse side of the front panel and fold out – and now your project is ready for decorating!



Cut pieces of patterned papers to decorate as follows:

Large front panel – 3 3/8" x 3 3/8"

Smaller front panel – 3 3/8" x 1 7/8"

Inside back panel – 3 3/8" x 3 3/8"

Strip across front panel – 5 1/2" x 3/4"



If you wish to pop a piece of paper into the barrel of your mini pen, remove the ink and cut a piece to fit – I used a Pentel Mini RSVP pen and cut a piece of patterned paper to measure 1 1/2" x 1" and tightly rolled it to fit in there
