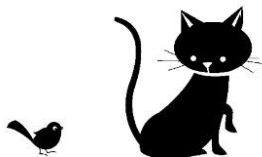

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

January Paper Pumpkin Kit - Key to My Heart

Stamps: Country Bouquet (160377)

Punch: Country Bouquet (160382)

BUNDLE: Country Bouquet Bundle (160383)

Designer Series Paper: Country Floral Lane DSP (160375)

Die Cutting: Stylish Shapes Dies (159183)

Cardstocks: Basic White (147114)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114)

Misc: Pastel Adhesive Backed Sequins (160387)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Stampin' Seal (152813)

Hearts & Keyhole Card

Instructions:

1. Take the keyhole card base
2. Cut a piece of patterned paper from Country Floral Lane DSP to measure 4" x 4" and use dimensionals to adhere inside, behind the keyhole
3. Cut out three hearts from another piece of patterned paper – adhere one inside the keyhole so that it is peeking out – and the other two on the card front – the one on the left with Dimensionals and the one on the right with tape
4. Cut out the leaves and adhere to the side of the left heart
5. Stamp your sentiment directly onto the card base
6. Cut out two pink hearts and use dimensionals to adhere in place
7. Dot on three gold sequins and your card is ready for giving!



Cascading Hearts Card

Instructions:

1. Take the other pink card base
2. Cut a piece of patterned paper from Country Floral Lane DSP to measure 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" and adhere over the gold textured card base panel
3. Die cut a large circle from white cardstock and adhere in place
4. Cut out four large hearts from another piece of patterned paper – adhere three of them cascading down the left side of the circle – use dimensionals to add the final bottom heart
5. Cut out five small hearts and do the same thing down the right side – use tape to adhere them all
6. Stamp the sentiment and use a banner die to cut it out – adhere it just tucked inside the large hearts
7. Cut out small hearts and adhere in place
8. Dot on three pink sequins and your card is ready for giving!
