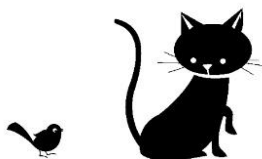

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Heart Shapes: Heart Boxes Add On (162417)

January Paper Pumpkin Kit - Key to My Heart - Calypso Coral Bakers Twine

Stamps: Country Bouquet (160377)

Punch: Country Bouquet (160382)

BUNDLE: Country Bouquet Bundle (160383)

Die Cutting: Alphabet a la Mode Dies (160750), Stylish Shapes Dies (159183)

Designer Series Paper: Country Floral Lane DSP (160375)

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Vellum (101856)

Inks: Sweet Sorbet (159216), Mint Macaron (147106)

Misc: Flat Adhesive Backed Pearls (160449)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Tear & Tape (138995), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Tools: Bone Folder (102300), 1/8" handheld Circle Punch

Take one of the boxes from the Heart Boxes Add-On Kit:



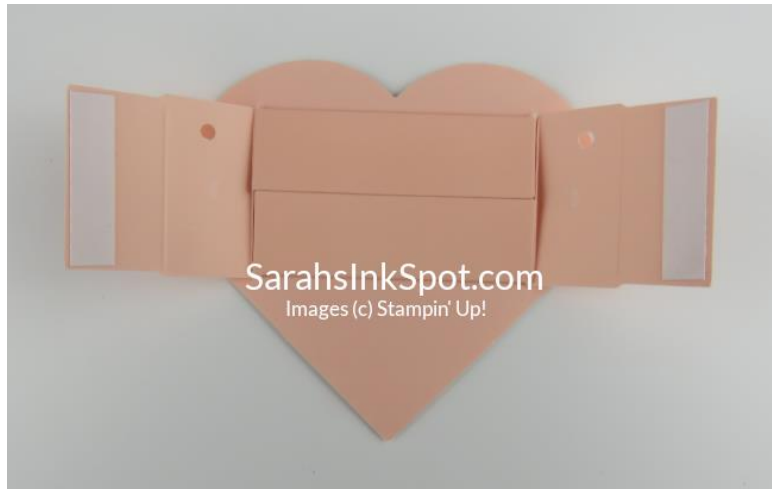
Turn over and punch a hole in the tab panel closest to the heart – about 1/4" down from the top edge and centered within the panel



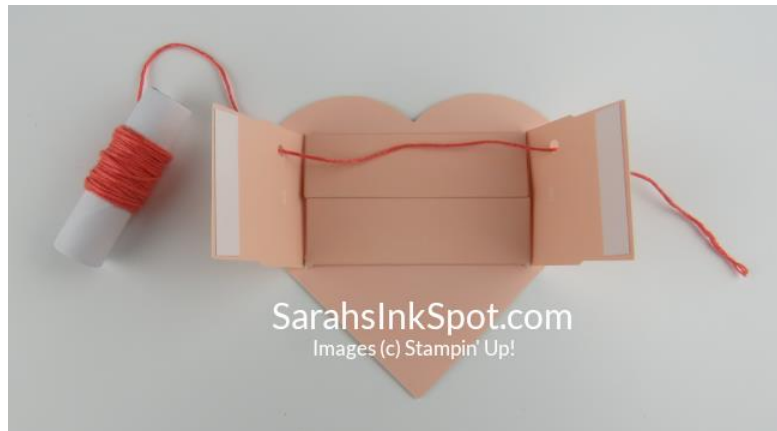
Fold along all score lines and use a bone folder to get them crisp



Fold the small end tabs in and tuck behind each long panel - use strong adhesive tape to adhere in place to the back of the heart



Thread bakers twine through the holes – when through, tie a double knot in the end so that it won't easily slip back through



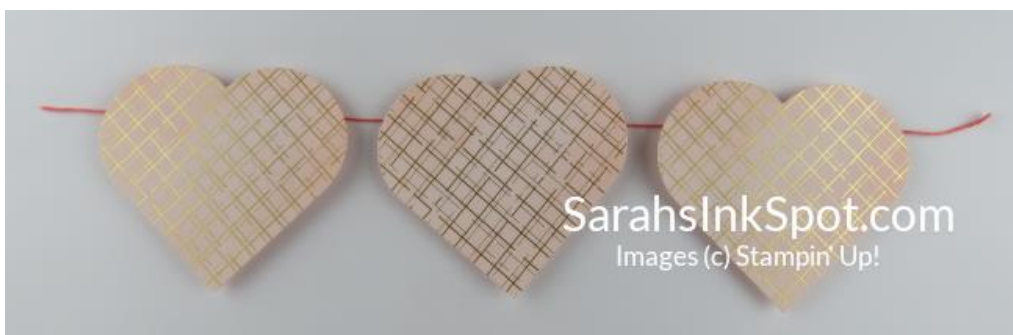
Close the panels, pull the twine so that it is tight but being sure to leave a good couple of inches at the end, and use the sticky sealant on the flaps to adhere them together



Repeat and add more hearts until you have your desired number – this is what the back will look like



Turn over, and you are ready to add letters!



I die cut circles from Vellum cardstock and letters to go on them using dies from Alphabet a la Mode Dies



I used a Fine Tip Glue Pen to apply adhesive to the back of the letter and adhered in place in the center of each circle – I then turned over the circle and did the same thing on the back of the vellum following the contours of the letter to adhere them to the hearts



And now they are ready for the fun bit – decorating!
