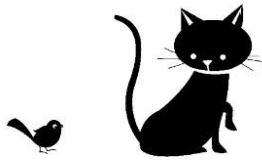

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Love Cats (160410)

Die Cutting: Scalloped Contours Dies (155560), Conversation Bubbles Dies (160636), Stylish shapes Dies (159183)

Cardstocks: Sweet Sorbet (159268), Basic White (159276), Basic Black (121045)

Designer Series Papers: Country Floral Lane DSP (160375), Country Gingham 6x6 DSP (160388)

Inks: Jet Black Stazon Ink Pad (101406)

Blends Marker: Sweet Sorbet Blends Combo Pack (159224)

Misc: Classic Matte Dots (158146)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)

Hanging Out Love Cats Card



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Instructions:

1. Use the largest die from Scalloped Contours Dies to die cut the black scalloped mat and adhere to the Sweet Sorbet card base
2. Stamp the cat onto the white layer and adhere onto the black mat
3. Use a Sweet Sorbet Light Blends Marker to color the heart
4. On a piece of scrap white cardstock stamp the sentiment and use a die from Conversation Bubbles Dies to cut it out – use dimensionals to adhere in place
5. And your sweet card is ready for giving!



Cutting measurements:

Sweet Sorbet card base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" - scored at 4 1/4"

White layer: 4 1/2" x 3 1/4"

Head Over Heels Love Cats Card



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Instructions:

1. Use the largest die from Scalloped Contours Dies to die cut the black scalloped mat and adhere to the Sweet Sorbet card base
2. Cut a piece of paper from Country Gingham DSP and adhere on top
3. Stamp the cat onto the white layer and use a die from Stylish Shapes Dies to cut it out - adhere onto the patterned paper
4. Use a Sweet Sorbet Light Blends Marker to color the heart
5. On a piece of scrap white cardstock stamp the sentiment and use a die from Scalloped Contours Dies to cut it out – use dimensionals to adhere in place
6. And your sweet card is ready for giving!



Cutting measurements:

Sweet Sorbet card base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Patterned Gingham layer: 4 1/2" x 3 1/4"

Hi there Valentine Love Cats Card



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Instructions:

1. Use the largest die from Scalloped Contours Dies to die cut the black scalloped mat and adhere to the Sweet Sorbet card base
2. Cut a piece of paper from Country Floral Lane DSP and adhere on top
3. Use another die from Scalloped Contours Dies to cut a scalloped white layer – use your paper trimmer to trim away the scallops but leave the stitched rectangle just inside
4. Stamp the cat onto the white layer and adhere onto the patterned paper
5. Use a Sweet Sorbet Light Blends Marker to color the heart
6. On a piece of scrap white cardstock stamp the sentiment and use a die from Conversation Bubbles Dies to cut it out – use dimensionals to adhere in place
7. And your sweet card is ready for giving!



Cutting measurements:

Sweet Sorbet card base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" - scored at 4 1/4"

Patterned Hearts layer: 4 1/2" x 3 1/4"

I love the clean & simple look of these cards but if you want to add a little bling, I added some Classic Matte Dots to these two cards as an example:
