Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Conversation Bubbles (160628)

Die Cutting: Conversation Bubbles Dies (160636), Playing in the Rain Dies (160550)

BUNDLE: Conversation Bubbles Bundle (160637) Designer Series Paper: Rain or Shine DSP (160540)

Cardstocks: Basic White (159276), Crushed Curry (131199)

Inks: Early Espresso Ink (126974)

Twine: Bakers Twine Essentials Pack (155475)

Misc: Adhesive-Backed Milky Dots (160582), Yellow Tissue Paper, Cadbury Creme Egg

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430), Tear & Tape (138995)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300), Simply Scored (122334), Stampin Cut &

Emboss (149653), Paper Snips (103579)

The Bottom Box: cut a piece of cardstock to measure 5 5/8" x 5 5/8" and place into a scoring tool



Score at 1 7/8" on all four sides



Cut from the edge down to the intersecting score lines on each corner to create flaps



Fold along all score lines



And apply strong adhesive tape to all flaps, fold up and secure in place



The Lid: cut a piece of patterned paper to measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" and place into a scoring tool – score at 3/4" on all four sides



Cut from the edge down to the intersecting score lines on each corner to create flaps and fold along all score lines



And apply strong adhesive tape to all flaps, fold up and secure in place



And then place the lid onto your base – and now it's time to decorate!



This is how I decorated – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:

I used my paper trimmer to cut strips of yellow tissue paper to fill my Easter themed box:



And a Crème Egg fits in there perfectly:
