Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Irresistible Blooms (161141) - the flower & sentiments

Dies: Irresistible Blooms Dies (161149) – the dotted circle die cut window, flower & leaves

BUNDLE: Irresistible Blooms (161150) – includes the stamp set & set of dies

Cardstocks: Basic White (159276), Gray Granite (146983), Soft Succulent (155776)

Inks: Jet Black Stazon Pad (101406), Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad (132708)

Blends Markers: Fresh Freesia Stampin' Blends Combo Pack (155518), So Saffron Stampin' Blends Combo Pack

(154905) – to color the flower

Embellishments: Adhesive-Backed Milky Dots (160582) or similar

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Cutting Measurements:

Basic White Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored at 4 1/4"

Gray Granite Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4"
Basic White Die Cut layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Take the Gray Granite layer and adhere to the Basic White card base

- 2. Take the Basic White layer and use a die from Irresistible Blooms Dies to cut the dotted circle on the left side adhere to the Gray Granite layer
- 3. Use Jet Black Stazon Ink & a stamp from Irresistible Blooms to stamp 'hello' on the lower right side
- 4. Use Tuxedo Black Memento Ink to stamp the flower use Stampin' Blends to color it and adhere to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals
- 5. Use two solid leaf dies from Irresistible Blooms Dies to cut the base leaves from Soft Succulent cardstock and then use the intiricate leaf veins to cut the top pieces use Fine Tip Glue to adhere together and adhere to the card each side of the flower
- 6. Add three Adhesive-Backed Milky Dots or similar embellishments where desired and your pretty card is ready for giving!
