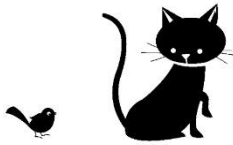

Tropical Leaf Card

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Tropical Leaf – (161242) – *the leaves & sentiment*; Petal Park (160571) – *the flowers*

Punch: Tropical Leaf Punch (161248) – *to cut out the large leaves*; Petal Park Builder Punch (160576) - *to cut out the flowers*

BUNDLES: Tropical Leaf Bundle (161249), Petal Park Bundle (160577)

Embossing: Cane Weave 3D Embossing Folder (160580) – *the textured background*

Dies: Deckled Rectangles Dies (159173) – *the center panel*

Cardstocks: Basic White (159276), Granny Apple Green (146990)

Designer Series Papers: Dandy Designs DSP (160836)

Inks: Early Espresso (147114), Granny Apple Green (147095), Flirty Flamingo (147052), Lemon Lime Twist (147145), Garden Green (147089)

Embellishments: Flat Adhesive Backed Pearls (160449)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Dimensionals (104430)

Cutting Measurements:

Basic White Card Base: 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Granny Apple Green Layer: 4" x 5 1/4"

Embossed Basic White Cardstock Layer: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Adhere the Granny Apple Green layer onto the Basic White card base
2. Use the Cane Weave 3D Embossing Folder to texture the Basic White layer and adhere in place
3. Use a Deckled Rectangle Die to cut out the center panel – stamp the sentiment - and use tape to adhere in place
4. Stamp two small leaves with Lemon Lime Twist Ink and the leaf veins in Granny Apple Green Ink – cut out with Paper Snips and use tape to adhere in place
5. Stamp two large leaves with Granny Apple Green Ink and the leaf veins in Garden Green Ink – use the coordinating Tropical Leaf Punch to cut them out – adhere the bottom one with tape and the top one with Dimensionals
6. Stamp two flowers and use the coordinating Petal Park Builder Punch to cut them out – adhere the top one with tape and the bottom one with a Dimensional
7. Add a Flat Adhesive Backed Pearl to the center of each flower and your pretty card is ready for giving!
